## Q. Who can apply?

A: Following are the candidates who can apply for MAT -

- 1. Candidates must have obtained Bachelors Degree in any discipline from a recognized University.

# Q. How to apply for MAT?

A: Candidates have three options to apply for MAT. They are -

#### Option 1

- 1. Candidates can get MAT form along with MAT Bulletin / CD on payment of Rs 1200/ only.
- 2. The forms are available from listed branches of Bank of Baroda, Axis bank or listed study centers of AIMA or from AIMA, New Delhi.

# Option 2

- 1. Candidates can make a crossed Demand Draft of Rs 1200/ in favor of "All India Management Association" payable at Delhi from any Bank.
- 2. Candidates have to register online at website www.aima-ind.org/matmay12
- 3. Candidates have to provide their Demand Draft details while online registration

#### Option 3

- 1. Candidates can do payment through Credit Card
- 2. Candidates have to do online registration for Credit Card mode of payment
