Guidelines for improving Quality of B.Ed. Course to be implemented from the Academic Year 2012-13

- 1. The approval of the teaching staff of the college is mandatory. The Colleges shall submit the staff list for approval by the University on or before 30th November 2012 for the academic year 2012-13. The same be hosted in the website of ANU and NCTE. The college should also arrange to host the same in its website.
- If any staff member leaves the college during the academic year after the approval of his/her
 name, the management of the college has to fill that vacancy and get the necessary approval
 from the university within a month's time.
- 3. The information about the attached model school be furnished at the time of the staff approval and invariably the teaching practice and practical examinations be conducted in that notified model school or with the students of that school in the premises of the college.
- 4. The University will not appoint the internal practical examiners from the academic year 2012-13 under any circumstances.
- 5. Task force (s) be constituted for verification and authentication of the projects/records before commencement of the practical examinations.
- 6. The University authorities/committees may inspect the college at any time and review the status of submission of records, class work and other academic activities.
- 7. The teacher educators should strictly follow the guidelines of the B.Ed. Common Core Curriculum while assigning project works to the student teachers.
- 8. The teacher educators should also observe the instructional hours prescribed for each topic, subject and project without deviation.
- 9. The student should attend internship/block teaching program within 8 kms. radius of the college in order to facilitate the supervision by the concerned lecturers. The teacher educators should supervise the teaching activity of the student teachers and put their signatures on the records on the day of visit and maintain the details of their visits.
- 10. All the records/projects, including computer education project/record, must be written in candidate's own handwriting.
- 11. The colleges shall strictly posses and follow the rules and regulations stipulated from time to time by the NCTE and the University in conducting the B.Ed. program and any violation be seriously viewed and appropriate action will be initiated against those colleges as per the rules of the University.
