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I am to state that the Registrar, Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, in his Circular referred to above, informed that among the other posts, 04 posts of Registrars (OB) and the tentative place of availability of vacancy or its likelihood will be at Bombay, Patna, Earnakulam and Madras Benches of the Tribunal and 04 posts of Joint Registrars and tentative place of availability of vacancy or its likelihood will be at Ahmedabad, Calcutta, Lucknow, Jaiputh, Banglore (likely) and Cuttak Benches of the Tribunal, and the eligible officers are likely to be fill up in the Central Administrative Tribunals on deputation basis for a period of one year likely to be extended or curtailed in administrative exigencies. The Registrar, Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, has also mentioned that the maximum age limit for those appointments shall not exceed 56 years on the closing date of receipt of application and the number of vacancies and place of posting are subject to change. 

CIRCULAR

Subject: Filling up of the vacant posts in the Central Administrative Tribunal on deputation basis.

It is proposed to fill up the following posts in the Central Administrative Tribunal on deputation basis for a period of one year likely to be extended or curtailed in administrative exigencies. The Pay and allowances and other terms of deputation of the officers/officials selected for the said posts will be regulated in accordance with the instructions contained in the Department of Personnel & Training OM No.6'8/2009-Estt.(Pay-II) dated 17/06/2010. The employees of Central Administrative Tribunal are entitled for and may continue to retain General Pool Residential Accommodation as per extant rules. The name of posts, classification, likely place of posting, tenure, scale of pay and eligibility criteria for filling up of these posts on deputation basis are as under:-

REGISTRAR (OB) (04 Posts)
