***CATEGORY-B ADMISSIONS INTO B.E/B.TECH, B.ARCH &
B.PHARMACY COLLEGES***

In pursuance to the stay orders granted by the Hon'ble High court of A.P on G.O.Ms.No.66 & 67 dt: 03.09.2012, the managements of Private Unaided Engineering, Pharmacy & Architecture colleges in the State offering B.E/B.Tech, B.Pharmacy and B.Arch courses for the year 2012-13 are hereby informed to conduct admissions into category-B seats (Management Quota) strictly following the rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.74 & 75 dt: 28.07.2011 & amendment G.O's 93, 94, 47 & 48. To ensure conduct of said admissions in a fair & transparent manner the Competent Authority has constituted Inspecting Teams to oversee such admissions and in this context the Principals of the colleges are required to cooperate and provide information/records to the said Teams at the time of visits to the colleges. Further, it has come to the notice of the competent authority that some colleges are notifying very high registration fee preventing many students from applying for admission into their colleges; this amounts to exploitation and unfair practice. **GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION INTO CATEGORY-'B' SEATS IN B.E/B.Tech
/B.PHARMACY/B.ARCH PROGRAMMES FOR THE YEAR 2012-13**

In pursuance to the stay orders granted by the Hon'ble High court of A.P on G.O.Ms.No.66 & 67 dt:03.09.2012, All the managements of Private unaided Minority & Non-Minority Engineering , Pharmacy & Architecture colleges in the state are hereby informed that they shall have to strictly adhere to the rules of Admissions prescribed in G.O.MS.No.74, & amendments in G/O.Ms.No.93 &47 (for Non-Minority Institutions) & G.O.Ms.No.75 & amendments in G.O.Ms.No.94 & 48 (for Minority Institutions) for admitting students under Category-B in B.E/B.Tech/ B.Pharmacy & B. Arch., programmes for the year 2012-13.

A. Rules of Admission:

1. The Institutions that are approved by All India Council for Technical Education and permitted to fill NRI seats not exceeding 5% of the sanctioned intake in each course for the academic year shall admit NRI candidates (sons and daughters of NRIs) who have passed the qualifying examination with not less than 50% of marks in prescribed group subjects or 50% aggregate marks in the qualifying examination or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) equivalent to 5 on a scale of 10.
2. The remaining seats shall be filled on merit basis with candidates belonging to other States and Union territories who have secured rank at AIEEE and secured not less than 45% of marks in the prescribed group subjects in the qualifying examination.
3. The seats remaining unfilled from 1 and 2 above shall be filled with eligible candidates on merit basis.

* **Eligible** candidate means:

- a) The Candidate shall be an Indian National or Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card Holders.
- b) In respect of Under-graduate Professional Courses in Engineering (Including Technology) the candidate should have completed 16years of age as on 31st December of the Academic year for which the admissions are being conducted.
- c) The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination (10+2) conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh or equivalent with Physics & Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry/Bio-Technology/Biology subjects and obtained atleast 45% marks in the group subjects (40% in case of candidates belonging to reserved categories and should have secured a rank at the Common Entrance Test.

4. There after, if any seats still remain unfilled such seats may be filled on merit basis with candidates securing not less than 50% of marks in aggregate / group subjects in the qualifying examination. **Note: Foreign National are not eligible for admissions.**

B. Procedure for admissions:

- (i) The Managements of the Colleges shall notify the details of courses offered with intakes, schedule of admissions, cost of Application form and Minority/Non Minority, statues in popular news dailies one in each language i.e., English, Telugu, & Urdu which is to be displayed on the Colleges website and also on the college notice board.
- (ii) The blank application forms for admission in 'B' category seats shall be made available to the candidates from the college counter on payment of the prescribed fee. The facility for downloading the form of application from the college website should also be provided. In this case, the cost of procuring the application form shall be paid to the college by the applicant at the time of submission of the duly filled in application forms.
- (iii) The college authorities shall enter the day wise sale of applications with the name of the candidates and address in a Register opened for the purpose and it shall be made available for inspection for any Officer authorized by the Competent Authority.
- (iv) The College shall issue an acknowledgment / receipt for the applications received.
- (v) The Management shall prepare the merit list of eligible applicants for each course and announce the same by displaying both on the website and notice board of the college for at least two weeks from the date of announcement.
- (vi) The Institution shall obtain ratification from the competent Authority for all the admissions conducted under category B seats by the Institution.
- (vii) The Management shall collect the Tuition fees as prescribed by AFRC for category 'B seats.

- (viii) The Managements shall comply with the above instructions and failure in implementing the same shall entail to withdrawal of Government permission, University affiliation and AICTE approval.
- (ix) **After scrutiny, the Competent Authority shall send the ratified list of admitted candidates from outside the State, NRIs and other admitted by the Institution to the University concerned and also to the respective Institutions.**
