**INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES UNDER FOREIGN NATIONALS' CATEGORY  
AT ANNA UNIVERSITY, CHENNAI – 600 025, INDIA**

**1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

**1.1. Application**

The application form may be downloaded from the website: [www.annauniv.edu/cia/adm.php](http://www.annauniv.edu/cia/adm.php)

**1.2. Eligibility and Academic Qualifications**

**B.E. / B.Tech. Degree (Four years):** Candidates must have passed the qualifying examination, i.e. (10 + 2) of Indian System or its equivalent (completed 12 years of school education).

Candidates must have studied in English medium or having proficiency in English language and obtained a pass in the qualifying examination with minimum of 50 percentage of marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics for admission to all programmes including Industrial Bio-Technology.

**B.Arch. Degree (Five Years):** The qualifying examination is a pass in 12th Grade or its equivalent examination with mathematics as one of the subjects. In addition, the candidates must have passed the National Aptitude Test (NATA) conducted by the Council of Architecture, India ([www.nata.in](http://www.nata.in)).

**1.3. Registration Fee**

A Bank Draft for US \$ 200 drawn in favour of **the Director, Centre for International Affairs, Anna University, Chennai, India** payable at **New York** drawn from the Nationalised Banks of India or other International Banks with branches in India should be submitted along with the application. Check whether the Demand Draft has routing number and seal and is signed by the authorised official.

**1.4. Last date for Receipt of Application**

Application complete in all respects should reach **the Director, Centre for International Affairs, Anna University, Chennai-600 025, India** on or before **31 July 2012**.

### **1.5. Selection of candidates :**

Selection of the candidates will be **done on first come first served basis subject to availability of vacancies and production of the following documents:**

1. Proof for the Citizenship of the candidate.
2. Passport of the candidate.
3. Valid student visa.
4. PIO / OCI card (In case of Citizen of Indian Origin)
5. Qualifying mark list of the candidate.
6. School Transfer Certificate or Migration Certificate.
7. Certificate showing that the candidate has proficiency in English language.
8. Eligibility Certificate from Indian Embassy for B.E. / B.Tech / B.Arch \*\*\*.
9. Proof of Financial support.
10. Bank draft for US \$ 7500(US dollars seven thousand five hundred only)

**Note:** \*\*\* If the candidate has studied in a Non-Indian Government board of education system in abroad or in India, the eligibility certificate obtained from the Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi or Indian Embassy in abroad, where the candidate has studied should be submitted.

#### **1.5.1. Final allotment of the branch of study will be done after verification of the certificates.**

### **1.6. Payment of Tuition Fee:**

On receipt of the allotment order, the candidate has to pay the prescribed fee immediately in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of the **Director, Centre for International Affairs, Anna University, Chennai, India** payable at **New York**. Check whether the Demand Draft have routing number and seal and is signed by the authorised official.

#### **1.6.1. Fee Structure :** US\$ 7500 per year for all UG Programmes.

US\$ 29,000 Fee payable in one installment per Course.

US\$ 36,500 Fee payable in one installment for B.Arch (10 semesters).

### **1.7. Fitness:**

Candidates have to submit a medical fitness certificate at the time of counseling as per Annexure - II.

## **2. GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **2.1. Reporting to the University:**

Normally, the academic session begins by **July – August** every year. Candidates selected for admission are required to report to the Deans of the campus concerned on the date mentioned in the allotment order. If the candidate fails to do so, the offer of admission will automatically stand cancelled.

### **2.2. Hostel Accommodations:**

A separate hostel is available for international students. Application can be made at the time of admission. Interested candidates may apply. They have to pay the prescribed fee as per Hostel Rules. The Hostel Mess is run on dividing system.

### **2.3. Other Fee:**

Fees applicable for Library, Examination, Students' Co-operative Society, Identity card (Smart card), etc should be paid in Indian rupees at the time of admission or when required to pay as per the rules.

### **2.4. Requirements for Completion of a Semester**

2.4.1. A candidate who has fulfilled the following conditions shall be deemed to have satisfied the requirements for completion of a semester.

Ideally every student is expected to attend all classes and earn 100% attendance. However, in order to allow provision for certain unavoidable circumstances such as hospitalization / accident / specific illness, the student is expected to earn a minimum of 75% attendance.

Therefore, he / she shall secure not less than 75% of overall attendance in that semester taking into account the total number of periods in all courses attended by the candidate as against the total number of periods in all courses offered during that semester.

2.4.2. However, a candidate who secures overall attendance between 65% and 74% in that current semester due to medical reasons (prolonged hospitalization / accident / specific illness / participation in Sports events) may be permitted to appear for the current semester examinations subject to the condition that the candidate shall submit the medical certificate / sports participation certificate to the Head of the Department. The same shall be forwarded to the Additional Controller of Examinations, Anna University, Chennai for record purposes.

2.4.3. Candidates who secure less than 65% overall attendance and candidates who do not satisfy the clauses 2.4.1 & 2.4.2 will not be permitted to write the end-semester examination of that current semester and will not be permitted to go to the next semester. They will be required to repeat the incomplete semester in the next academic year.

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
