

Applications are invited from Advocates, who are not less than 35 years of age and not more than 48 years of age in case of applicants belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes or 45 years of age in case of others and having not less than 7 years of practice as an Advocate in the Courts of Civil and Criminal jurisdiction as on the Fifteenth day from the date of publication of this advertisement, for filling up of 2 (two) vacant posts(provisional) in Grade-I of the Nagaland Judicial Service in the pay scale of Rs. 51,550-1230-58,930-63,070/- per month plus other allowances as admissible under the Rules (approximate total monthly emoluments will be about Rs. 91,404/-). The duly filled in application should reach the undersigned on or before the fifteenth day from the date of publication of this advertisement.

A candidate must be a citizen of India as defined in Articles 5 & 6 of the Constitution of India and must be a holder of a Degree in Law of a recognized University.

80% of the posts to be filled up by direct recruitment are reserved for persons belonging to (1) Any Naga Tribe, (2) Kuki, (3) Garo, (4) Kachari and (5) Mikir, provided such persons are indigenous inhabitants of the State of Nagaland. Out of the 80% reserved posts, 25% shall be reserved for the persons belonging to the following 6 (six) Tribes of four districts of Mon, Tuensang, Kiphire and Longleng:

- (i) Konyak
- (ii) Phom
- (iii) Sangtam
- (iv) Yimchunger
- (v) Chang
- (vi) Khiamniungan

Further, 12% will be reserved for the following Tribes in the proportion indicated below:

(i) Chakhesang/Pochury of Phek District : 6%

(ii) Zeliang : 4%

(iii) Sumis of Kiphire District : 2%

No application will be accepted after the closing date. Attested copies of certificate of proof of his/her educational qualification, Bar Council's Registration, Age and Practice certificate along with 2 (two) copies of recent passport size photograph duly attested should be submitted. An IPO of Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two hundred only) for General candidates and Rs. 100/- (Rupees One hundred only) in case of SC/ST candidates payable to the Registrar, Gauhati High Court, Kohima Bench, should be sent along with the application form.

The candidates shall have to appear in a written examination consisting of the following papers:

- 1. <u>Paper-I</u>: One paper of 100 marks of 3 (three) hours duration to test the General knowledge, aptitude, intelligence, test of comprehension and expression of law and General English including Essay writing on legal topic and information technology.
- 2. <u>Paper-II</u>: One paper of 100 marks of 3 (three)hours duration regarding objective questions and problems of law as regards the Transfer of Property Act, Civil Procedure Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act, Indian Penal Code, Limitation Act.
- 3. <u>Paper-III</u>: One paper of 100 marks of 3 (three) hours duration consisting of Judgment writing (Paper book to be supplied) Legal theories on jurisprudence, provision of Constitution of India.

Note: The candidate is expected to refer to the relevant decisions of the Apex Court and the High Court while writing answers in Papers II and III.

All the candidates who clear the written examination shall be called for the **Viva-Voce** Examination of 50 marks. Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes who obtain 50% or more marks in the written

examination shall be eligible for viva-voce. Other candidates who obtain 60% of more marks in the written examination shall be eligible for viva-voce.

The written test/viva voce test and all other conditions for appointment shall be as per the Nagaland Judicial Service Rules, 2006. The candidates shall have to appear in the written test/viva voce Examination at their own expense, as and when called for.

The number of post advertised is existing vacancies only but it may vary at the time of selection. Mere selection would not per se entitle a candidate to claim appointment.

A fresh recruit joining the service shall not be governed by the existing Nagaland Services (Pension) Rules, 1969 and orders issued thereunder, from time to time. Their pension and other retirement benefits will be governed by "the new defined Contributory Pension Scheme" of the Government of Nagaland.
