- **General / OBC candidates should have secured 60% marks (aggregate of all years / semesters) and above in Diploma and SC candidates should have secured minimum 50% marks.**
- **Upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years for OBC and 5 years for SC candidates.**

The applicants should be compulsorily registered in any of the Employment Exchanges in Karnataka and should meet the eligibility criteria stipulated above. The method of selection will be written test followed by interview for shortlisted candidates. Ability to read, speak and write Kannada is essential. Computer literacy is desirable. Relaxation in age / experience may be granted in deserving cases.

Candidates selected as Engg. Asst. Trainees will initially undergo training for a period of 1 year during which stipend of Rs.4,000/- p.m. will be paid. On successful completion of the training and on passing the gradation test they will be placed on the regular pay scales indicated above.

**The photocopies (legible & complete) of the following documents should be enclosed along with the application form:**

1. SSLC marks card.
2. Marks card of each academic year / semester of Engg. Diploma in the relevant discipline.
3. Final Diploma Certificate issued by the Competent Authority /Board of Technical Education.
4. Employment Registration card (*valid as on the date of application*).
5. Candidates need to submit copies of the relevant caste / community certificate issued by the competent authority, if applicable.
6. In case of candidates belonging to OBC category the certificate should be in non-creamy layer format (Annexure-A) for applying for posts under Government of India dated on or after **01.03.2013**.

7. Candidates who are employed in Govt/ Quasi Govt/ Public Sector Undertakings are required to submit their applications through proper channel or furnish No Objection Certificate at the time of interview.

***(Note: Candidates who are yet to complete their Diploma in Engg. / awaiting results need not apply.)***

#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

Application form should be submitted in the prescribed format in A4 size paper. Application form may be downloaded from the website.

**Application Fee:** Candidates belonging to General and OBC category are required to remit an amount of Rs.300/- towards application fee. SC candidates are exempted from payment of application fee.

**Mode of payment of application fee:** Candidates are required to download and print the bank challan from the website. The challan (in triplicate) is to be filled by the applicant and submitted to the nearest SBI Branch, along with an application fee of Rs.300/- plus bank charges of Rs.25/- . On submission of the challan unique transaction number (**Journal Number**) will be generated and the same would be written by the staff at the Bank. The bank portion of the challan will be retained by the staff and the remaining 2 portions will be given to the candidate. The candidate is to ensure that the 'Journal Number' is entered on the challan before leaving the bank. If the Journal number is not mentioned in the challan, the candidate should insist for the same and get it entered before leaving the Cash counter.

The candidate is required to enter the details of the challan and the 'Journal Number' in the application form. On completion of the application form the same is to be submitted along with the photocopies of required documents and attach the Company's copy of the challan and send it by '**Ordinary Post**', to **Deputy Manager (HR/Central), Bharat Electronics Limited, Jalahalli Post, Bangalore 560 013**. The candidate's copy may be retained by the candidate for future reference.

**The last date for receipt of applications is 21<sup>st</sup> September 2013.**

Applications that are not in the prescribed form, incomplete, illegible, without complete enclosures / challan or received after due date and are not meeting the criteria indicated above will be summarily rejected without assigning any reason whatsoever. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained. Candidates may be debarred at any stage of the selection process, if it is found that they do not fulfill the prescribed eligibility criteria. Mere short-listing / attendance in the written test / interview does not entitle them to any claim for the post. Canvassing in any form at any stage will result in disqualification.
