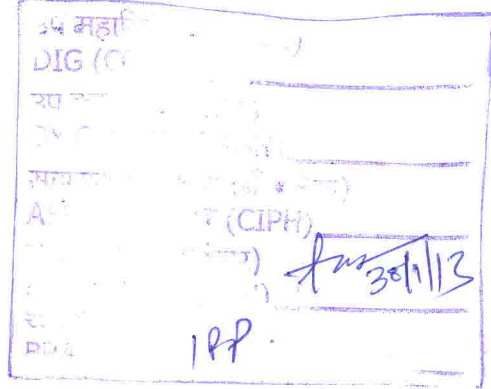



(3) Age

(4) Educational & Professional Qualifications

(a) Specialist Doctors

(i) A recognized medical qualification included in the first or second schedule or part II of the Third Schedule (other than that licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holders of educational qualifications included in Part II or the Third Schedule should also fulfill the conditions stipulated in Sub-Section (3) of Section (13) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

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- (ii) Post-Graduate Degree/Diploma in the concerned Specialty as mentioned in Section – A or Section – B of Schedule- VI or equivalent.
- (iii) 1½ years' experience for post Graduate Degree holder & 2½ years for Diploma holder in the concerned specialty after obtaining the post Graduate Degree/Diploma or equivalent.

(b) **General Duty Medical Officer**

- (i) A recognized medical qualification included in the first or Second Schedule or Part II of the Third Schedule (other than that licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act,1956. Holders of educational qualifications included in Part II or the Third Schedules should also fulfill the conditions stipulated in sub-Section (3) of Section (13) of the Indian Medical Council Act,1956.
- (ii) Completion of compulsory rotating internship.

(5) **Medical Examination**

Immediately after interview on the same day the candidates will be medically examined by a Board of Medical Officers detailed by BSF Composite Hospital Srinagar. Appointment will be subject to medical fitness.

(6) **Period of contract**

The appointment will be purely on contractual basis for a period of three years or till the appointee attains the age of 65 years or till a regular incumbent joins, whichever is earlier. Thereafter, the contract will lapse automatically. However, the appointment can be terminated at any time by giving one month's notice (on either side) without assigning any reason by paying/refunding one month's salary.

- (7) No Extension beyond the stipulated three years will be given. However, such a contractual appointee can apply again afresh on completion of 3 years tenure.



(8) **Entitlement of Leave**

The leave entitlement may be governed in terms of DoP&T's OM No. 12016/3/84-Estt (L) dated 12.04.1985, as amended from time to time.

- (9) The appointee shall not have any claim or right to regular appointment to any post under CAPFs.
- (10) The appointee shall be on whole time appointment of the institution and shall not accept any other appointment, paid or otherwise, during the period of contract.
- (11) Other conditions of contract will be governed by the relevant rules and orders issued from time to time.

- (16) **Other terms and conditions for the Post of Specialist Doctors and GDMOs (General Duty Medical Officers) in BSF on contractual basis are as under :-**
- (i) The appointment process will be subject to prior approval of MHA.
  - (ii) If the candidates available for appointment are in excess of the advertised vacancies, then waiting list will be prepared in order of merit at this location. The waiting list will be valid for one year from the date of interview. If vacancies at certain locations exit even after these interviews as well as after exhausting the waiting list then interview will be held again at specific locations with the due approval of MHA.
  - (iii) The selected candidate will undergo medical test as prescribed for regular appointment and his appointment will be subject to verification of character & antecedents.
  - (iv) The appointee shall perform the duties assigned to him. The competent authority reserves the right to assign any duty as and when required. No extra/ additional allowance will be admissible in case of such assignment.
  - (v) The appointee shall not be entitled to any benefits like provident fund, pension, gratuity, medical attendance treatment, seniority, promotion, etc. or any other benefits available to the Government servant appointed on regular basis.
  - (vi) Non – practicing allowance will not be admissible.
  - (vii) Only consolidated salary will be admissible, no dearness allowance and other allowance as are admissible to the Govt servant shall be admissible.

- (viii) The appointment carries with it the liability to serve in any part of the country.
- (ix) Appointment is subject to the physical fitness from the competent medical board for which he/she will be sent to the designated Medical Authority every year.
- (x) The appointee is required to submit a declaration regarding his/ her marital status.
- (xi) On appointment, the appointee will be required to take an oath allegiance to the Constitution of India and make a solemn affirmation to the effect in the prescribed proforma.
- (xii) The appointee will not be entitled to any TA/DA for joining the appointment.
- (xiii) If any declaration or information given by him/her proves to be false or if he/she is found to have willfully suppressed any material information, he/she will be liable to be removed from service and any such other action as the Govt may deem necessary.
