In addition to the prescribed fees for the examination, a sum of ₹ 15/- has to be paid by way of D.D. separately towards examination application forms (OMR Sheet). ₹ 100/- towards the statement of marks card and Rs.05/- for scrutiny fee which has to be paid by all including those who are exempted from payment of examination fees.

As per the University Circular No.RPS/Fee/2009, dated 12.11.2009, in respect of University Departments / Constituent Colleges students / residing in BBMP area should pay the examination fees to the University shall be by way of crossed DD only drawn on any nationalized bank in favour of the Finance Officer, Bangalore University, Bangalore and payable only at State Bank of Mysore, Nagarabhavi Branch, Bangalore – 560056. This shall be remitted either at the City Finance Office Cellor Floor, Library Building, Central College Campus, Bangalore – 01 or at the Office of the Finance Officer, Ground Floor, Administrative Building, Jnanabharathi, Bangalore-56 and obtain an official receipt for the same. The said receipt issued as proof of payment of amount, shall be enclosed to the intended application compulsorily. Any other form of remittances like Cash, Cheque, IPO, Bank Challans, Money Order, Mail transfer etc., is not accepted.

For PG Centres/Colleges/Institutions and students located/residing in places other than BBMP limit area mentioned above they shall continue to follow the existing practice of remitting fees in State Bank of Mysore branches.

Payment of examination fee and submission of application for the examination alone do not entitle a student to take the examination, if he/she is not eligible as per Rules / Regulations governing the eligibility, viz., Approval of Admissions / Shortage of Attendance etc.

The Chairpersons of Departments / Principals of Colleges shall ensure that the students whose admissions are not approved by the University/having shortage of attendance such candidates shall not be allowed to appear for the examination.

The candidates whose admissions are approved by the University are required to pay the prescribed examination fees, marks card fees. As per the Govt. order, the candidates whose family income is not more than Rs.11,000/- P.A. & who have to appear for the said examination for the first time are exempted from the payment of examination fees. However, SC/ST/BT students have to pay only a sum of Rs.100/- for issue of marks card, Rs.15/- for OMR Sheet and Rs.05/- for scrutiny fee for the first time and subsequent attempts also. (Certificates should be enclosed).

The examination fee once paid will not be refunded or re-adjusted under any circumstances.

The candidate should have 75% of attendance during the Semester. Those candidates who have shortage of attendance may not be permitted to pay the examination fee and submit their applications. The Internal Assessment Marks secured by the candidates shall be displayed atleast one week prior to the last working day of each semester on the Notice Board. The statement of Internal Assessment marks shall be sent to Registrar (Evaluation) one week before the commencement of theory examinations of that particular semester.

A candidate is permitted to carry all the previous uncleared papers to the subsequent semester/semesters.

Such of those candidates who have failed/remained absent/opt to improve in any one or more papers (theory/practical) shall appear/improve in such paper/s within the next two successive examinations of that semester.

A candidate is permitted to apply for improvement in any paper of the particular semester within 30 days from the announcement of results of that semester. Hence those who have already applied for improvement through their HOD's/Principals in any of the papers for the I Sem. should pay the examination fees after obtaining the permission from this office and submit the application specifically mentioning the subjects for which the improvement is sought. The HOD's/Principals should send the list of applications for improvement separately with all details such as Candidate name, subject/paper of the semester.

The Chairpersons/Principals are requested not to insist the students for those who "FAILS IN AGGREGATE" to obtain the permission for improvement. The Chairpersons / Principals are requested to accept the applications directly as repeaters. The University will issue improvement permission only for the students who have passed the examination / subject and have obtained less percentage as per regulation.

Examination for odd/even semester shall be conducted respectively at the end of odd/even semester (odd with odd, even with even).

The candidate shall take the examination as per the syllabus and the scheme of examination in force during the subsequent appearances.

A repeater (including a candidate who seeks improvement) shall not be eligible for any Roll of Honors (Ranks).

Improvement is allowed only in theory and practical. However, the marks secured in the previous attempt shall be retained if the same is higher. There is no provision for improvement of internal assessment / Viva / Dissertation / Project / Field Work marks.

A candidate should complete the Master's degree examination within 4 (four) academic years from the date of his/her admission.

The application forms may be obtained from the Heads of Institutions concerned. The applications with necessary enclosures and the fee paid Challan/Receipt/Copies of the Marks Cards of Previous examination should be submitted to the concerned colleges within the date mentioned above.

The practical examinations for the course wherever prescribed will be notified by the Chief Superintendents of the concerned Departments / Colleges.

The Heads of the Institutions are requested to send applications to the Office of the Registrar (Evaluation), "Pareeksha Bhavan", Jnanabharathi Campus, Bangalore - 560 056, along with candidates list including repeaters of I Sem. in FOUR SETS of the respective examination and Subject-wise statement in Triplicate on or before **29.01.2011.** The Chairman / Principal should not allow the candidates whose admission are not approved by the University, to write the examination.

Question paper requirement along with one set of candidate list shall be submitted to the Confidential Section directly on or before <u>29.01.2011</u>, failing which, penal fee of Rs.3000/- will be levied for late submission.

Please note that if the candidates list and applications are not received within this date, Centre Declaration will not be made by this office for conduct of examination to the students of such Departments/colleges.
