12.	Hindi	Evidence of quality research and expertise in teaching at least in three areas of the subject courses prescribed for M.A. Hindi.
13.	Political Science & International Relations	Evidence of quality research and expertise in teaching at least in three areas of the subject courses prescribed for Political Science & International Relations.
14.	Psychology	Evidence of quality research and expertise in teaching at least in three areas of the courses prescribed for Psychology.
15.	Sociology	Evidence of quality research and expertise in teaching at least in three areas of the subject courses prescribed for M.A. Sociology.

#### GENERAL:

- 1. Applicants are advised to submit the applications to the University well in advance, without waiting till last date, to avoid postal delay or any other unforeseen problems. The University will not be responsible for any postal delay at any stage.
- 2. The University may offer lower post to a candidate, who may have applied for a higher post, in case suitable candidates are not available for the advertised post.
- 3. Central University of Bihar has launched process for regular appointment of faculty. It is quite likely that all the positions may not be filled by the regular faculty. To efficiently manage teaching of courses and supervision of students in various academic programmes, critical strength of faculty would be necessary and, therefore, the advt. also includes invitation of proposal for appointment on short term basis (up to 3 years) of faculty on deputation/contract basis. Those especially eminent scholars serving or retired who fulfill the requirements of specialization of a subject may also apply. The university also reserves the right to identify such distinguished people for appointment on deputation/contract basis on terms and conditions to be decided by the university as per norms. However, such appointment on deputation shall be only at the level of Professor and Associate Professor.
- 4. It will be open to the University to consider, on its own, names of suitable candidates who might have not applied. Candidate shall not claim it as a right.
- 5. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. The University reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed as decided by duly constituted Screening Committee/s and approved by the Competent Authority. Call letters for attending interview will be sent only to the short-listed candidates by Speed Post or Registered Post or Courier service. No correspondence will be made with applicants who were not short-listed/not called for interview.
- a) Reservations for SC, ST, OBC and Persons with Disabilities candidates exist as per the Rosters being maintained by the University for various posts in accordance with the guidelines of the UGC. Candidates applying for the Reserved Posts should clearly state to which category they belong. They must also enclose a Certificate issued by Tahsildar/Mandal Revenue Officer/ Equivalent authority as proof to this effect, without which the applications will not be considered.
  - b) In case a candidate wants to claim benefits under the Persons with Disabilities category, the candidate's relevant disability should be not less than 40 per cent. Proof, to this effect, must be enclosed with the application, without which the application will be treated as 'general (unreserved)'.
  - c) Candidate applying for the post(s) reserved for O.B.C., must submit an attested copy of caste certificate specifically mentioning Creamy Layer-exclusion in the format prescribed by Govt. of India, issued by competent authority,

- vide Column 3 of G.O.I. Deptt. of Personnel and Training O.M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 8.9.1993 and modified vide DOPT's O.M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt.(Res) dated 9.3.2004, subsequently revised vide O.M. No.36033/3/2004-Estt.(Res) dated 14.10.2008, without which applications will not be considered. The form of Caste Certificate must be in the format as prescribed by the Govt. of India; otherwise the application will be summarily rejected without further consideration.
- 7. The University reserves the right to relax any of the qualifications, experience, etc., in deserving cases in respect of any post. Candidates shall not claim it as a right.
- 8. The number of vacancies of the posts indicated in this Employment Notification is tentative. The University reserves the right to fill any consequential vacancies, and /or to increase/decrease the number of posts and make appointments accordingly.
- 9. Selection will be made on the basis of candidates' previous record and their performance in the interview. The University may utilize seminar /colloquium/Lecture and/or any other mode as a supplementary method in selection process.
- 10. Candidates already in service submitting Advance Copy of their application may kindly note that if the original application through proper channel has not been received by the University by the last date mentioned in the employment notification, the candidate/applicant will have to submit a 'NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE' obtained from his/her employer to the University at the time of interview, if he/she is called for interview.
- 11. Experience and qualifications will be reckoned as on the preceding-day to the last date of submission of (not the date of publication of the employment notification). Good photocopies of all certificates must be attached to the application:
- 12. Those who have joined / are joining the University service on or after 1st January, 2004 are covered under new pension scheme introduced by the Government of India (Central Government).
- 13. The University also reserves the right to select candidates with higher qualifications than what is specified or to select candidates who have not applied for the posts or those with different specialization.
- 14. As per ordinance of the university, probation period shall be two years and during such period any kind of leave to join other institution or lien is not permissible and, therefore, no application of probationer/contract faculty for employment in other institution is forwarded.

#### 15. FOR TEACHING POSITIONS:

- (a) A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Master's level for the SC/ST/Persons with Disabilities (Physical and Visual Disabilities) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions
- (b) A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks, to the PhD degree holders who have passed their master's degree prior to 19th Sept. 1991.
- (c) B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E  $\mathcal{C}$  F shall be regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed.
- (d) Under the term 'good academic record' the candidate must have obtained on an average of 50% marks in each of the two public examinations/degrees immediately preceding the Master's degree.
- All other relaxation and concessions as admissible by UGC, Govt. of India and amendments made from time to time shall be applicable.
- 16. **Canvassing or influencing** in any form on behalf of any candidate will disqualify such candidate. University reserves the right to take appropriate action against uncalled for influence and threat.
- 17. Read carefully teaching/research requirements of the relevant discipline and apply only if you have requisite qualifications and experience. However, those who do not meet the academic standards and requirements of CUB should not apply for the sake of applying.
