Walk in Interview for Technical Assistants in the Campus Networking Centre

A walk in interview will be conducted on 18th February 2013 at 9:00 am for short-listing persons with requisite qualifications and skill sets for working in shift type job in the campus networking centre of the institute, for short term engagement as and when needed, purely on temporary contract basis with remuneration of ` .345/- per day up to a maximum of 20 days in a calendar month.

The Campus Networking centre is working 24 hours a day, 365 day a year.

Qualifications:

B Tech/BE in Computer Science & engineering, Information Technology, Electronics Engineering

OR

3 Year Diploma in Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics Engineering Computer Hardware Maintenance, preferably with syllabus of Polytechnic institutes in Kerala or its equivalent from other states.

Experience (Essential):

One year experience

1. In installation, Management & maintenance of Operating systems like windows and Linux
2. In Networking
3. In troubleshooting and maintenance of laptop and desktop computers

Experience (Desirable):

One year in installation, Maintenance and management of IP Phones and IP Phone server

Candidates without Original Experience Certificates showing adequate essential experience, Bio-data, Original Mark lists and Certificates in respect of Qualifications and Age will not be allowed to attend the interview. Preference will be given to those with experience in IP phone (desirable experience)

Interested candidates may appear, on their own cost, for a walk in interview at 9.00 am on 18th February at the Office of National Institute of Technology Calicut, along with original and a set of photocopy of certificates for proof of their qualifications, experience, skills etc. Only those who fulfill the qualifications and produce the Certificates in original will be allowed to appear for the Interview. No TA/DA will be paid. Degree/diploma from Government/Government recognized Institutions. Diagnostic test will be conducted if required (on the same day). Once selected, the candidate will have to report for duty immediately.

This appointment is proposed to be made under the contingency provisions for the Institute and does not entail any person any right for continuation or for any other allowances/benefits. The duties shall be assigned by the competent authority and the persons engaged have to attend the duties with due diligence and care. Failure to discharge duties shall lead to forfeiture of the offer of engagement forthwith, without any notice thereof. The remuneration shall be disbursed based on the periodical report on conduct and the monthly attendance from the Sections to which the persons are attached.
