Xerox copies of two CME Programme Certificates who have attended the programme and the filled in application for Provisional Certificate should be forwarded to this University in respect of IInd year candidates on or before the last date for submission of exam application for issue of hall tickets.

The amount of prescribed exam fees collected from all the candidates for all years may be paid

through online by RTGS/NEFT at HDFC Bank. The details of remittance should be furnished for each year in separate sheet to the University for issue of hall tickets.
