- 2. Eligibility Criteria for admission to Certificate of Proficiency Minimum Qualification: Class 10 (at least 50%).
- 3. Weightage will be given to candidates with higher qualifications. SSC with 80% or above 10 points, 1<sup>st</sup> class 8 points, Less than 1<sup>st</sup> class 5 points, Graduates 3 points, Post graduates 3 points, M.Phil 2 points and PhD 2 points.
