DBT-RGYI Project

Applications are invited for one Junior Research Fellow position in a DBT-RGYI project, 'Molecular determinants of catalytically inactive variants, MMS2 and UEV1A, for specificity of UBC13-E3 ligase interaction in signaling innate immune response and post-replication DNA repair'.

Job responsibilities: Cloning and mutagenesis, recombinant protein purification, *in vitro* assays.

Required qualification: M.Sc. in any area of Life Sciences who have NET qualified and desirably with a valid CSIR/UGC/DBT/ICMR JRF.

Age limit: 28 Years

Duration: The position is for three years. Initial appointment is for one year and extension is based on a satisfactory review of work done during previous year. The position will be co-terminus with end of the project.

Emoluments: Junior Research Fellow Rs. 12000 + 30% HRA for 1st year & 2nd year; Rs 14000+ HRA for 3rd year. (HRA is admissible only if the stay is outside the campus).
