i) The candidates will be required to answer in OMR sheet which will be signed both by the candidate and invigilator.

ii) The OMR answer sheet of written test will be processed/ scanned in an electronic machine. Any wrong entry of roll number, name, question booklet number, question paper series etc will render the OMR sheet invalid and the same will not be evaluated. The concerned candidates will be responsible for such mistake on their part.

- i) The answer sheet will be signed both by the candidate and invigilator.
- **Note:-** Qualifying marks shall be 35% for General Candidates & Ex-Servicemen and 33% for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes /Other Backward Class in the written examination.
- (f) Merit List Merit lists in each category namely, Gen, SC, ST, OBC and Ex-servicemen will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the written examination.

(3) For Head Constable(CM) (DE & LDE)

The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. Candidates will have to undergo the following Tests:-

POLICE, Tigri Camp, New Delhi-110062. ITBP will not be responsible for any postal delay. The appeals received after the prescribed 15 days or without relevant documents will not be entertained.
- v) The decision of the re-medical board of ITBP shall be final and no 2^{nd} appeal will be entertained.
