### RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT SURGEON /ASSISTANT COMMANDANT (VETERINARY) INDO-TIBETAN-BORDER POLICE FORCE.

Applications are invited from Indian Citizens for filling up 32 posts (General-13, SC-8, ST-1 and OBC-10) of Assistant Surgeon (Assistant Commandant/Veterinary) Group-'A' Gazetted Non Ministerial Combatised Post in the Pay Band-3 of Rs.15600-39100/- + Grade pay Rs.5400/- + 25% NPA in ITBPF (MHA) Govt. of India. However, vacancies could be increased/ de-creased. On Joining the organization, selected candidates will be governed by ITBPF Act 1992 and ITBPF Rules 1994 as amended from time to time and are liable to serve anywhere in Union of India or outside. The posts being in combatised stream of the Force, the officers selected will have to wear the rank and badges of the post as per Govt. of India orders/ instructions.

2. The candidates who will be called for interview are entitled to traveling expenses as per provisions contained in Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India OM No.F.190145/1/74-E.IV(B) dated 30-1-76 (Government of India order No. 08 below SR-132) i.e. ordinary bus fare or single 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail fare chargeable by passenger train by the shortest route from the railway station nearest to the normal place of residence or from where they actually perform the journey whichever is nearer to the place of interview and is in excess of 250 Kms for both outward and return journey. However, in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST communities, 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail fare or bus fare shall be payable to the candidates provided the fare of the first 30 Kms for both outward and return journey is borne by the candidate. In both the cases, it will be subject to production of certificate of non-employment in Government service from an MP or MLA or Gazetted Officer; of the place where he is residing.

**Concession/Allowances:-** In addition to above scale of pay, DA, CCA, HRA and Transport allowance wherever admissible, as per the Government order and rates will also be payable. The applicants will also be entitled to the following concessions/allowances:-

- (i) Free ration in kind when posted to specified Border areas.
- (ii) Special compensatory (remote locality) allowance at prescribed rates when posted to specified Border areas.
- (iii) Free supply of fuel at Army scale for heating and washing purpose at certain heights.
- (iv) Rent free un-furnished family accommodation at Bn HQrs and Training Centers as per availability. In forward areas, camp type single accommodation will be provided, free of cost.
- (v) Special duty allowance at 12½ % of pay when posted in the North-East including Sikkim & Leh.
- (vi) Initial uniform grant of Rs.14,000/- (in two installments). Renewal uniform grant of Rs.3000/- after every 3 years and kit maintenance allowance at the prescribe rate..

4. **Eligibility condition:-** The candidates applying for the post must fulfil the following conditions of eligibility:-

- Age:**
- (i) Not exceeding 35 years as on the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates i.e. 30-11-2012 (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunchal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkam, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, The Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands or the Union Territory of Lakshadweep).
  - ii) Relaxable upto five years in the case of Government servants in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government from time to time. Also relaxable upto 05 years in the case of SC/ST candidates and three years for OBC and other special categories of personnel in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time. Relaxable upto a maximum of 05 years in the case of Medical Graduates in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry who joined the Army Medical Corps as Short Service Regular Commissioned Officers and are released after completing the initial period of assignment of five years. The age relaxation up to five years shall also be admissible to the SSCO whose assignment has been extended beyond five years and in whose case the Ministry of Defance

issues a certificate that they will be released on three months notice on selection from the date of receipt of offer of appointment. The relaxation in age limit shall be admissible upto a maximum of ten years if such Govt. Servent and SSCOs belong to the SC/ST and upto a maximum of eight years, if such officers belong to the OBC.

**Educational Qualification:**

- i) Bachelors Degree in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry from a recognized University.
- ii) Registration with Veterinary Council of India.

**5. Other eligibility conditions:**

Physical and medical standard: The candidate should conform to the following physical standards:-

- (i) Height: 157.5 Cms  
(Relaxable by 2 Cms in respect of Gorkhas, Garwalies, Kumaonies, Dogras, Marathas and by 3 cms in respect of adivasis).
- (ii) Chest: 77 Cms. Unexpanded and 82 Cms. Expanded.
- (iii) Weight: Proportionate to height and age.
- (iv) Possessing good mental and sound health free from any physical defect.

- (i) The total amount of myopia (including the cylinder) shall not exceed minus 4.00 D. Total amount of hyper metropia (including the cylinder) shall not exceed plus 4.00 D.
- (ii) The type of correction is permissible only by conventional spectacles and not by contact lenses, IOL or redial keratotomy, Laser In situ Keratômieusis (LASIK) etc.

(b) The candidates must not have knock-knees, flat foot or squint in eyes and they should possess high-grade colour vision. The candidates will be tested for colour vision by Ishihara's test as well as Edrich green's Lantern tests. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

Candidates should be in good physical and mental state for duties in high altitude and to serve in border areas with extreme climatic conditions. Every candidate on having been selected will be produced before a duly constituted Medical Examination Board for examination of his Medical Fitness. The said Medical Board will issue Medical Examination report of the candidate in the prescribed form. The Government of India reserves to themselves right to reject or accept any candidate after considering report of the Medical Examination Board.

**6. Mode of Selection:**

The selection process will consist of following parts:-

- Part-I : Interview (Personality Test).  
Part-II : Detailed Medical Examination.

Candidates would be required to appear before the Selection Board for interview. The interview and detailed Medical Examination will be held at Delhi on a date to be intimated later.

**7. Application:-** Candidates fulfilling the above conditions of eligibility may apply on white plain paper giving their particulars in the proforma attached with this advertisement. The candidate must send the following documents with application:-

- (i) Certified true copy of the matriculation or equivalent certificate as proof of date of birth with mark sheets.
- (ii) Certified true copy of certificate of Bachelors Degree in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry with marksheet.
- (iii) Certified true copy of registration with Veterinary Council of India.
- (iv) Certified true copy of caste certificate in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- (v) Two identical photographs (recent passport size) 5 x 7 cms approx, duly attested by Gazetted Officer, one pasted on application form and the other attached to the application duly attested on reverse.
- (vi) Two self addressed stamped envelop of 11.5 Cms x 27.5 Cms size.
- (vii) Attested copy of NOC issued by the employers in case the candidate is a Govt. employee, be attached.

8. **Closing date of receipt of application:-** The last date of receipt of application is 30-11-2012 for all states except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir, Lahual & Spiti Distt. and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba Distt of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is 07-12-2012.
9. **Conditions of service:-**
- (i) Candidates shall be required to serve in the Force for a minimum period of 10 years. If any officer after joining the service wants to resign from the service before the expiry of 10 years, he is required to refund a sum equal to three months pay and allowances attached to the post or the cost of training imparted to him by the Force, whichever is higher.
10. **General:-**
- (a) Applications complete in all respect should reach “ **The Senior Administrative Officer (Pers), Directorate General, ITBPF, MHA/Govt. of India, Block-II, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi-11003**” by the closing date. Cover containing application must be superscribed in block letter as “**APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT SURGEON/ ASSISTANT COMMANDANT (VETERINARY) IN ITBP-2012.**”
- (b) Application which is not on prescribed proforma or not accompanied by the required enclosures or incomplete or defective applications, shall be summarily rejected. No representation or correspondence regarding such rejection shall be entertained under any circumstances.
11. Selected candidates will have to undergo basic training and such other courses as prescribed in the Force from time to time.

12. **Important instructions:-**

The candidates shall produce the original certificates at the time of interview. Non-production of certificates shall be disqualification. If any one who does not fulfill the minimum physical standards, educational qualification and other qualification, chooses to apply, he runs the risk of incurring wasteful expenditure for which the Govt. of India or the Selection Board accept no responsibility. Attested copies of testimonials/certificates should only be attached with the application. Candidates already in Govt. service must apply through proper channel.

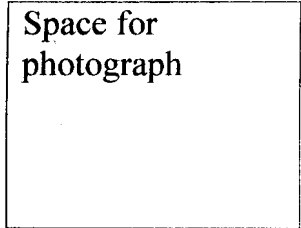
