### DIRECTORATE GENERAL, INDO-TIBETAN BORDER POLICE FORCE, MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS, GOVT. OF INDIA.

#### RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT COMMANDANT (ENGINEER) IN INDO-TIBETAN BORDER POLICE FORCE.

Applications are invited from Indian Citizens for filling up 10 (Ten) 06 UR, 03 OBC & 01 SC posts of Assistant Commandant (Engineer) (Group-'A' Non ministerial Combatised Post) in Pay Band-3 Rs.15,600-39,100/- plus grade pay Rs.5400/- in the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force (MHA) Govt. of India. On joining the organization, selected candidates will be governed by ITBPF Act. 1992 and ITBPF Rules, 1994 as amended from time to time and are liable to serve anywhere in Union of India or outside. The posts being in combatised stream of the Force, the officers selected will have to wear the rank and badges of the posts as per Govt. of India orders/instructions.

2. The candidates who will be called for interview are entitled to traveling expenses as per provisions contained in Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India, O.M. No. F.190145/1/74/E.IV(B) dated 20/01/1976(Govt. of India decision No.08 below SR-132) i.e. ordinary bus fare or single 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail fare chargeable by passenger train by the shortest route from the railway station nearest to the normal place of residence or from where they actually perform the journey whichever is nearer to the place of interview and is in excess of 250 Kms for both outward and return journey. However, in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST communities, 2<sup>nd</sup> class rail fare or bus fare shall be payable to the candidates provided that the fare of the first 30 Kms for both outward and return journey is borne by the candidate. In both the cases, it will be subject to production of certificate of non-employment in Government service from an MP or MLA or Gazetted officer; of the place where he is residing.

3. **Concession/Allowances:-** In addition to above scale of pay, DA, CCA, HRA and transport allowance wherever admissible, as per the Government orders will also be payable. The applicants will also be entitled to the following concessions/allowances:-

- (j) Free ration in kind when posted to specified Border areas.
- (ii) Special compensatory allowance (remote locality) allowance at prescribed rates when posted to specified Border/Hill areas.

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- (iii) Free supply of fuel at Army scale for heating and washing purposes at certain heights as per availability.
- (iv) Rent-free un-furnished family accommodation at Bn Hqrs and Training Centres as per availability. In forward areas, camp type single accommodation will be provided free of cost as per availability.
- (v) Special duty allowance at 12½ % of pay when posted in the North-East including Sikkim & Leh.
- (vi) Initial uniform grant of Rs.14,000/- ( in two installments). Renewal uniform grant Rs.3000/- after every 03 years and kit maintenance allowance at the prescribed rate.

4. **Eligibility conditions:-** The candidate applying for the post must fulfill the following conditions of eligibility:-

- Age:-** (i) Not exceeding 30 years as on the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India i.e. 30/01/2013 (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir state, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands or the Union Territory of Lakshadweep).
- (ii) Relaxable upto a maximum of five years in the case of Government servants in accordance with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government from time to time. Also relaxable upto 05 years in the case of SC/ST candidates and three years for OBC categories in accordance with the orders of the Central Govt. from time to time. The age relaxation is also admissible to the ECOs/SSCOs, as per GOI, Deptt of Pers & Trg O.M. No.39016/15/79-Estt(C) dated 7<sup>th</sup> September, 1981 and O.M. No.36034/8/88-Estt(SCT) dated 19<sup>th</sup> May, 1988.

**Educational Qualification:-** Degree in Civil Engineering from an Institution recognized by the Central or State Govt.

5. **Other eligibility conditions:-**

**Physical and medical standard:-** The candidate should conform to the following physical standards:-

I:- **FOR MALE**

- (i) Height: 165 Cms (relexable by 2 Cms in respect of Gorkhas, Garhwalis, Kumaonis, Dogras, Marathas and by 3 Cm in respect of Adivasis.
- (ii) Chest: 81 Cms Un-expanded and 86 Cms Expanded.
- (iii) Weight: 50 Kg

**Eye sight:- (with or without glasses)**

Distant vision: 6/6 in one eye 6/9 in the other eye  
Near Vision: 0.6 in one eye and 0.8 in other eye.

**II:- FOR FEMALE**

- (i) Height: 157 Cms  
(ii) Chest: Not applicable  
(iii) Weight: Proportionate to height

**Eye sight:- (with or without glasses)**

Distant vision: 6/6 in one eye 6/9 in the other eye  
Near Vision: 0.6 in one eye and 0.8 in other eye.

**Important:-** The candidate should not have knock-knees, flat foot or squint in eyes and they should possess high grade colour vision. The candidate will be tested for colour vision by Ishihara's test as well as Edrich Green's Lantern tests. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

Candidates should be in good physical and mental state for duties in high altitude and to serve in border areas with extreme climatic conditions. Every candidate on having been selected will be produced before a duly constituted Medical Examination Board for examination of his medical fitness. The said Medical Board will issue medical examination report of the candidate in the prescribed form. The Govt. of India reserves to themselves the right to reject or accept any candidate after considering report of the Medical Examination Board.

6. **Mode of selection:-** The selection process will consist of following parts:-

<b><u>Part-I Preliminary physical screening</u></b> for conforming to the prescribed physical standard.

(PET is qualifying in nature and no marks will be allotted for it)

**Part-III Written Examination:-**  
Those who qualify in the preliminary physical measurement & PET would be put through the written examination on the same day. The written examination which will include objective type questions would comprise of only one paper to test the ability of the candidate:-  
(a) Professional subjects.  
(c) General Awareness, General Intelligence and General English.

**Part-IV: Interview (Personality test).**  
Those who qualify in the written examination would be required to appear before the Selection Board for interview on the following day.

**Part-V: Detailed Medical Exam.**

The venue of above exams will be at Delhi .

7. **Application:-**

Candidates fulfilling the above conditions of eligibility may apply on white paper in the prescribed proforma attached with this advertisement. The candidate must send the following documents with application:-

- (i) Certified true copy of the matriculation or equivalent certificate as proof of date of birth with mark sheets.
- (ii) Certified true copy of certificates in support of educational qualification as stipulated above.
- (iii) Certified true copy of the caste certificate in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates.
- (iv) Two identical photographs (recent passport size) 5 Cmsx7 Cms apprx. duly attested by a Gazetted Officer, one pasted on the application form and the other attached to the application, duly attested on the reverse.
- (v) Two self addressed stamped envelop of 11.5Cms x 27.5Cms size.
- (vi) Attested copy of NOC issued by the employer in case the candidate is a Govt. employee, be attached.

8. **Closing date for receipt of application:-** The closing date for receipt of applications is 30/01/2013 for all states except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of J&K State, Ldhaul & Spiti Distt and pangi Sub-Division of Chamba Distt of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is 13/02/2013.

9. **Conditions of service:-**

Candidate shall be required to serve in the Force for a minimum period of 10 years. If any officer after joining the service wants to resign from the service before the expiry of 10 years, he is required to refund a sum equal to three months pay and allowances attached to the post or the cost of training imparted to him by the Force, whichever is higher.

10. **General:-** Applications complete in all respect should reach "The Senior Administrative Officer (Pers) Directorate General, ITBPF, MHA/Govt. of India, Block-II, CGO Complex, Lodi Road, New Delhi-110003" by the closing date. Cover containing application must be superscribed in block letters as "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF ASSISTANT COMMANDANT (ENGINEER) IN ITBP-2012" Applications which is not on prescribed proforma or not accompanied by the required enclosures or incomplete or defective applications, shall be summarily rejected. No representation or correspondence regarding such rejection shall be entertained under any circumstances.

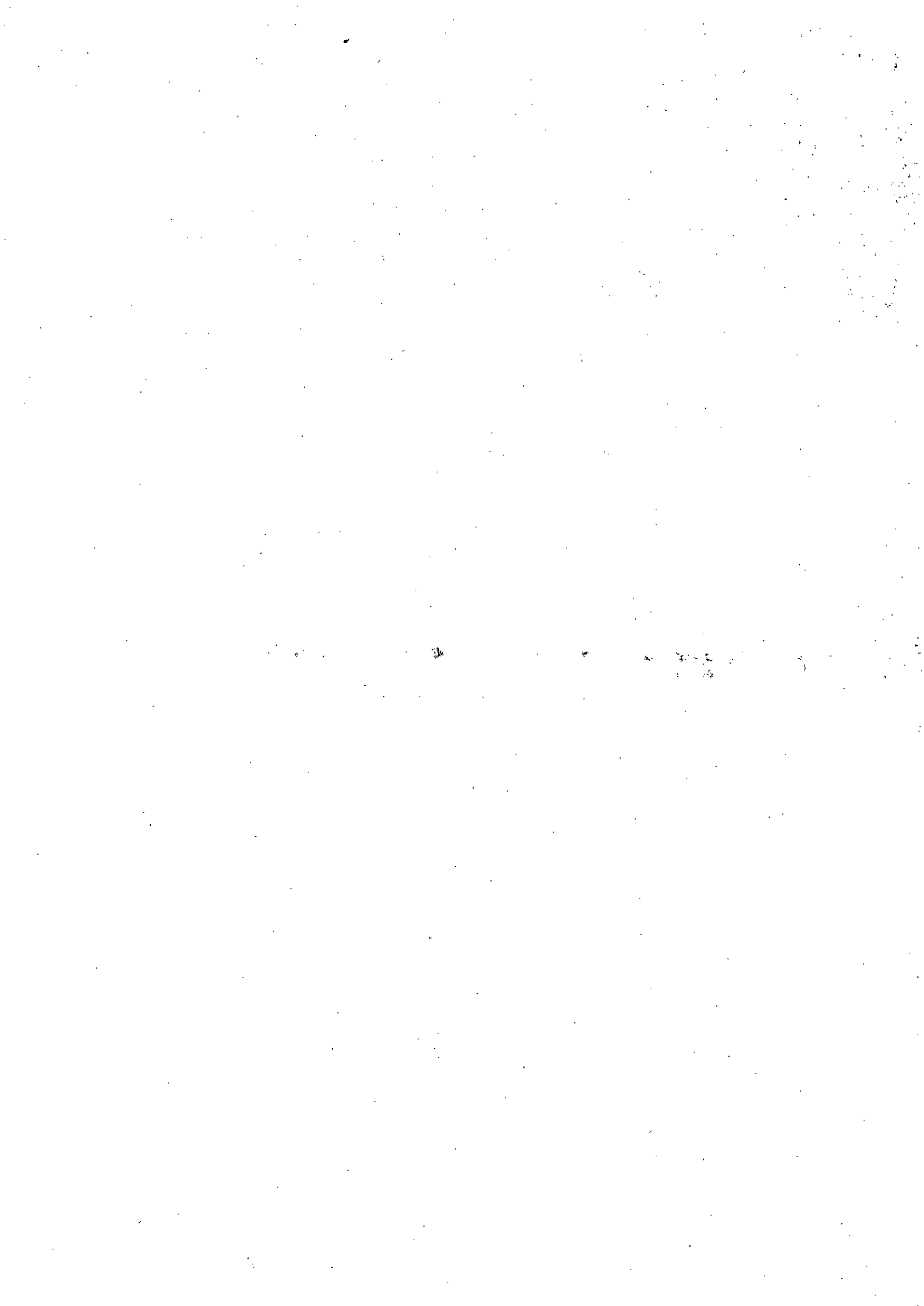
11. Selected candidates will have to undergo basic training and such other courses as prescribed in the Force from time to time.

**13. Important instructions:-** The candidates shall produce the original certificates at the time of interview. Non-production of certificates shall be dis-qualification. Attested copies of testimonials/certificates should only be attached with the application. Candidates already in Govt. service must apply through proper channel.

Applications received unsigned or incomplete in any respect will be rejected. Each application shall be accompanied by a crossed Indian Postal Order/Bank Draft worth Rs.50/-payable to the Accounts Officer, Directorate General, ITBP, New Delhi. The candidates belonging to SC/ST Community need not send prescribed fees alongwith their application form.
