Applications are invited from **Male Indian Citizens** for filling up 10 **vacancies** of **SUB-INSPECTOR (OVERSEER) Group 'B' Non-Gazetted** on temporary basis likely to be permanent in ITB Police Force. The posts have all India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules.

2. The last date of receipt of applications is **29-02-2012** for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul and Spiti District and Pangi Sub Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and the Union Territory of Lakshadweep for which last date is **07-03-2012**.

# 3. <u>PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES</u>

- a) **Pay Scale:** PB-II, Rs.9300–34800 + Grade Pay Rs.4200/- per month.
- b) Other allowances: The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass, free medical facilities and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. <u>These posts will be covered under new</u> <u>Restructured Defined Contribution Pension Scheme</u>.

## 6. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS**

(I) <u>Age:</u> Between 20 to 25 years (Cut off date for determining the age will be 29-02-2012)

## <u>Note</u>

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by 5 years and for OBC by 3 years.
- (b) The upper age limit shall be relaxed by the length of military service increased by 3 years in case of Ex-servicemen.
- (c) Upper age limit is relaxable up to 5 years in case of Government servant with the instructions or orders issued by the Central Government.
- (d) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years in case of the children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots and riots of 2002 in Gujarat. ## 7. PHYSICAL STANDARDS

Note: - Candidate who intends to avail relaxation in Height/Chest measurement will have to submit certificate as per Annexure-'V'.

## 8. <u>MEDICAL STANDARDS</u>

- (a) <u>Vision</u>: Minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of both eyes without correction (i.e. without wearing glasses).
- (b) Must pass high grade colour vision test.

Must not have knock-knee, flat foot, varicose veins or squint in eyes.

Must not have any defect/deformity likely to interfere with the efficient performance of duties.

## 10. <u>APPLICATION FEE</u>

Note: - All the above original documents/certificates are required to be brought at the time of recruitment test for verification.

## 12. <u>SELECTION PROCESS</u>

The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. Candidates will have to undergo the following tests:-

- a) <u>**HEIGHT BAR-</u>** At the very beginning of recruitment process, candidates will go through the height bar test. The candidates not meeting the prescribed height will be eliminated.</u>
- b) <u>**RACE-</u>** Those who qualify the height Bar test, will be subjected to qualify the following race events for further test. No marks will be awarded for this test, which will remain only qualifying in nature. (Those who do not qualify will be eliminated at this stage itself)</u>

Race 100 meters	to be completed within 16 seconds
Race 1.6 kms.	to be completed within 10 minutes

- c) <u>Checking of Documents:</u> The original documents of candidates will be checked by the Board. Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification and photocopies will be retained with the application form. Those who clear this stage will go to PST.
- d) <u>Physical Standard Test (PST):-</u> Candidates who are found eligible on scrutiny of documents will be screened for Height, Chest and Weight measurements.

## e) <u>Physical Efficiency Test (P.E.T)</u>

The candidates who are found fit in PST events will be required to qualify Physical Efficiency Test (PET) consisting of following events:-

Long Jump	11 feet	03 chances to be given
High Jump	3 ½ feet	03 chances to be given
Shot Put	14.8 feet	03 chances to be given

<u>Note</u>: PST/PET will be qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks. Those who do not qualify in any PST/PET events will be discarded then and there and will not be allowed to appear in further event. No race or physical efficiency test (PET) will be held for Ex-servicemen.

f) **OMR Based Written Examination:** The candidates qualified in PST, Race and PET will be required to pass the written examination consisting of following:-

**Note**: Qualifying marks shall be 35% for General Candidates & Ex-Servicemen and 33% for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes /Other Backward Class in each paper of the Written Examination.

- i) The objective type question paper will be prepared on OMR based pattern.
- ii) The paper-I, General Engineering (Civil) shall be set both in Hindi and English.

- iii) Candidates will be required to answer in OMR sheet, which will be signed both by the candidate and invigilator.
- vi) The candidates will be allowed to take carbon copy of the answer sheet. Answer key to the question paper will be posted on the website and displayed on the notice board after the written examination is completed.
- v) The OMR answer sheet of written test will be processed/scanned in an electronic machine. Any wrong entry of roll number, name, question booklet number, question paper series etc will render the OMR sheet invalid and the same will not be evaluated. The concerned candidates will be responsible for such mistake on their part.

## (g) Interview (40 Marks)

The candidates who qualify the written test will be required to appear in interview (40 Marks) for assessment of personal bearing, response, aptitude and general level of intelligence etc. There shall be no qualifying marks for interview but the marks obtained by a candidate shall be added while drawing the merit list.

- (h) <u>Merit List:</u> Merit lists in each category namely, Gen, SC, ST and OBC will be drawn on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the written examination and interview. The candidates shall be called for Detailed Medical Examination (DME) as per the category-wise vacancies and strictly on the basis of this merit.
- (j) <u>Detailed Medical Examination</u>:- Candidates selected in order of merit as per category wise number of vacancies, will be put through detailed medical examination to assess their fitness.

## (k) Appeal against Detailed Medical Examination

i) A candidate declared unfit in detailed medical examination, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an appeal for his re-medical examination with duly filled Medical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed proforma (Annexure-'VI') as a piece of evidence about possibility of error of judgment in the decision of the Medical Officer at the time of Recruitment.

ii) The appeal for re-medical examination will not be taken into consideration unless it contains duly filled medical fitness certificate in the prescribed proforma (Annexure-'VI'), a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment by a Medical Officer.

iii) The appeal for re-medical examination will not be taken into consideration unless the original Rejection Slip issued by the Presiding Officer is enclosed and re-medical examination Fee of Rs. 25/- is also enclosed in form of Indian Postal Order or Demand Draft in the name of Commandant, Base Hospital, ITB Police, New Delhi.

(iv) The appeal should be submitted within 15 days from the date of rejection, to the authorities i.e. to whom the application was initially submitted. The

appeals received after 15 days will not be entertained. ITBP will not be responsible for Postal delay.

(v) The decision of the Re-medical Board of ITBP shall be final and no  $2^{nd}$  appeal will be entertained as per Govt. instructions and also no reply of the correspondence/ $2^{nd}$  appeal will be given/entertained.

- 13. Candidates who are already in Central/State Govt. service including Departmental Candidates should send their application through proper channel with NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from their Employer. Application received without proper channel and NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE will also be rejected.
- 14. All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment tests through admit card. Candidates should come duly prepared for 3-4 days stay under their own arrangements at the Recruitment Centre. Under any circumstances the Government shall not be responsible for damage/injury, if any, to the individual sustained during the recruitment. No TA/DA will be admissible. Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be entertained. No application after the last date as mentioned above will be accepted.
