

JOIN INDIAN ARMY – BE A WINNER FOR LIFE
OPEN ARMY RECRUITMENT RALLY AT UT OF LAKSHADWEEP ISLANDS
FROM 15 FEB TO 18 FEB 2013

1. An open recruitment rally for enrolment into Army will be organized by Army Recruiting Office, Calicut with effect from 15 Feb 2013 to 18 Feb 2013 at Government Stadium Kavaratti for **male candidates** of UT of Lakshadweep for Soldier General Duty, Soldier (Clerk/Stores Keeper), Soldier Technical, Soldier Nursing Assistant and Tradesmen categories.

2. **Rally Schedule** Candidates desirous of enrolment into Army for the above categories should report to the rally site by 0600 hours each day. Rally will be conducted as per programme given below :-

Note – All NCC/Sportmen/SOEX/SOS/SOW/SOWW will be screened for their respective trades/categories on the day of their respective districts as per pgme above.

3. **Physical Fitness Test.** Candidates are advised to prepare themselves for under mentioned Physical tests :-

(a) **1.6 km Run.** System of awarding marks to various categories in this test are as under:-

(c) **9” Ditch.** Candidates to qualify the test is mandatory but not awarded marks.

(d) **Zig- Zag Balance.** Candidates to qualify the test is mandatory but not awarded marks.

4. (a) **Physical Measurement Test for UT of Lakshadweep**

- (i) Ht 155 cms, Wt-50 kgs and chest 77/82 cms for Lakshadweep (Locals) only.
- (ii) Ht 165 cms, Wt-50 kgs and chest 77/82 cms for Lakshadweep (Settlers) only.
- (iii) Ht 155 cms for (Locals), 165 cms for (Settlers), Wt-48 kgs and chest 76/81 cms for Soldier Tradesman.
- (iv) Ht 155 cms for (Locals), 162 cms for (Settlers), Wt-50 kgs and chest 77/82 cms for Soldier Clerk/Store Keeper categories.

Note (a) **Locals.** Locals are people who originally belongs to the Island.

(b) **Settlers.** Settlers are people who have migrated from the main land and settled in the Island.

(Local Revenue Officials are requested to ascertain the above aspects)

(c) Eligibility criteria may change without notice.

(d) Candidates to undergo physical test at their own risk.

(e) Candidates are advised to get ear wax cleaned prior to attending rally.

(f) No TA/DA or any other expenses are admissible.

5. **Medical Acceptability for Recruitment of Candidates with Tattoos.** Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body is not acceptable and candidate will be barred from further selection. Tribes with tattoo marks on the face of body as per their existing custom and traditions will be permitted on case to case basis.

6. **Written Exam.** Common Entrance Exam of rally fit candidates will be held at Kavaratti on 24 Feb 2012 and balance candidates declared fit after medical review will be held on 28 Apr 2013 at ARO Calicut. All candidates are warned not to carry any type of communication device during written test. Candidates are liable to be frisked during CEE. Any violation by any candidate in this regard, apart from automatic disqualification of candidature and ban from future screening would also invite legal prosecution. There will be negative marking for GD & Tradesman Category.

7. **Service Benefits.** Total emoluments about Rs 16,000/- and above. Promotion from Sepoy to Subedar Major and Honorary rank of Captain. Opportunity to get commission as Gazetted Officer. Field/Border and High Altitude Area Allowances, Counter Insurgency Allowances. Free rail journey once in a year during leave and 50% concession on subsequent journey by rail during leave. Free ration, clothing and Government accommodation, medical and canteen facilities.

8. **Media conference & Ex servicemen Meet** A press meet is tentatively scheduled on 17 Feb 2013 at 1000 hours at rally ground. An ex-servicemen meet is scheduled on 18 Feb 2013 at 1100 hours.
