Sub:- Payment of Annual Examination Fees for M.A/M.Com (Previous and Final) May/June – 2012

The students who have enrolled in KSOU for M.A/M.Com (Previous and Final) SIM SCHEME are eligible to take the Annual Examinations to be held during May/June 2012.

May/June 2012 Examinations will be the last chance for the students who had joined the course between 2004-05 to 2008-09 under 90/10 (90 Theory 10 Assignment) scheme. Under any circumstances this provision will not be extended again.

Therefore, students are informed to pay examination fee as mentioned above along with improvement examination fee of Rs.1000 with the prior permission of the Registrar (Evaluation).

Students can select any one of the above Examination Centres (Freshers). Once they choose the Examination Centre, the candidate has to take examination in that particular centre alone during his/her next attempts. Change of Examination Centre is not allowed. Under special circumstances, permission will be granted with prior request on payment of fee Rs. 1000/- within 15 days prior to the commencement of examinations.

Students shall remit the fees in the nearby State Bank of Mysore or State Bank of India through the challan enclosed in the examination application. *Please mention the Year of Admission, Roll Number and Name of the Examination Centre on the Top of the Examination Application. Enclose the photocopy of Admission fee paid Challan along with Examination Application. Incomplete applications are liable to be rejected. DO NOT tear the original fee paid challan from the exam application.*

Students shall submit their filled-in Examination applications to The Registrar (Evaluation), Karnataka State Open University, Manasagangotri, Mysore – 570 006, either in person or by Registered Post / Courier.

Examination Applications received after 23-04-2012 will be rejected.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

1. Students who are admitted for M.A/M.Com/M.Sc programmes under Regulation-I should complete MPP Examination within Four (4) years of their admission. The results of the term-end-examination of the students will be withheld, in case they fail in MPP Examination.
2. If the total students strength is less than 50 in any examination centre, students opted for that centre will be directed to write the examinations at the nearest examination centre. This arrangement will be intimated to the students well in advance.
3. Examination fee once paid will not be refunded nor readjusted to the next examination under any circumstances.
4. Students who belong to SC/ST category and other reservation categories are also required to pay the examination fee in full.
5. Candidates shall take the examination as per the syllabus and scheme of the examination.
