The Students shall pay the fees as per the following schedules through “**Challan**” enclosed/printed in the Examination Application form and submit their Examination application through Registered Post to the **Registrar(Evaluation) KARNATAKA STATE OPEN UNIVERSITY, MUKTHAGANGOTRI, MYSORE-570006** after payment of examination fee in any of the State Bank of Mysore or State Bank of India in any Branches.

**Students appearing for the first time will have to pay for the whole examination in full.**

2. The dates of **Practical Examination** shall be notified during the Theory examination.
3. Admission Tickets will not be sent to the students by post. It shall be collected by the students in person from the respective Examination Centre two days prior to the commencement of Examination by producing the Identity Card.
4. All the candidates shall bring their Admission Tickets and Identity Cards to the Examination Hall without fail.
5. Applications received after the last date will be rejected without any correspondence.

**Note:-**Students are prohibited to bring Mobile Phones to the Examination Hall. If candidates are found with mobile phones it will be seized and a case of malpractice will be booked. The University is not responsible for any loss or damage to cell phones if found in the examination hall.
