INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

[To be followed scrupulously at the time of Convocation]

I. **Assemblage in the Convocation Venue:**

The candidates for admission to the several Degrees, diplomas and titles **shall assemble in the convocation venue by 9.45 a.m. on Sunday, the 9th December 2012** wearing the academic robes/ scarves pertaining to their respective degrees, diplomas and titles and shall take the seats allotted to them in front of chancellor.

On the procession entering the convocation Venue, the candidates and visitors shall rise from their seats and remain standing until the Chancellor, and other members of the procession have taken their seats

The candidates pertaining to all faculties shall rise from their seats when the Chancellor put them the following questions and clearly and audibly utter the answer given below

II. **Questions to the candidates by the Chancellor to admit them to the convocation:**

a) Do you sincerely promise and declare that if admitted to the degrees and titles for which you are severally candidates and for which you have recommended, you will, in your daily life and conversation, conduct yourselves as becoming Members of the University?

(Answer: **I do Promise**)

b) Do you promise that to the utmost of your opportunity and ability you will support promote the cause of morality and sound learning?

(Answer: **I do Promise**)

c) Do you promise that you will, as far as lies in you uphold and advance social order and the well being of youth fellowmen?

(Answer: **I do Promise**)

III. **Presentation of candidates individually:**

- a) Only candidates for research degree and recipients of medals and prizes for other degrees will be presented individually to the Chancellor. The Candidates for these Degrees or Medals when called out by the respective Deans of faculties shall go over to the dais, bow to the Chancellor after receiving their degrees / Medals and go back to their seats, remain standing until the Chancellor admits them to the degrees of respective faculties. There will be no individual presentation of candidates for other degrees.

IV. Presentation of candidates for Degrees other than those mentioned at Item III above:

The candidates for the Master's Degrees of various faculties shall rise from their seats and remain standing when they are presented to the Chancellor, and shall resume their seats only after the Chancellor admits the candidates to the degrees or respective faculties.

V. Singing of National Anthem:

During the singing of National Anthem after the Chancellor dissolves the convocation, the candidates pertaining to all Faculties shall remain standing along with Academic Senate Members and Visitors etc. till the national Anthem is sung. The Graduates and Visitors shall remain standing until the members of the Executive Council retire from the convocation venue:

- VI. The Candidates shall rise from their seats and remain standing until the candidates of concerned Faculty are being presented to the Chancellor. The candidates shall not leave their seats until the Convocation is dissolved.

NOTE:

- a. **All the DOCTORATE DEGREE HOLDERS , POST GRADUATES** who are in the habit of wearing Indian Costume or European costume (Shirt and Pants) **SHALL BE CLOTHED IN WHITE.**
- b. **Women graduates shall not be required to be clothed in white sari/dress or to wear any head dress. However they are advised to wear light colour sari/dress.**
- c. **The Recipients of all degrees, both men and women should wear an academic gown (White gowns for Ph.D. degree holders and Black gowns for others) and also a white/black cloth academic cap** or a turban.
- d. **The academic gowns will be made available at the venue on rental basis from a Chennai based company. The candidates has to collect the gowns by paying an amount of Rs 300/- (Rupees Three Hundred only)**
- e. **Rs 100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) are towards the rent of the Gown and Rs 200/- (Rupees Two Hundred only) is a deposit amount. The deposit amount of Rs 200/- will be paid back after the Gown is handed over to the Company person.**
