### Ph.D /M.Phil Admission Test 2013

The admission to Ph.D/M.Phil is based on PG Marks and Admission test. Equal weightage will be given to percentage of marks in post-graduation (Additional 15 Marks for MSWs from MZU) and marks secured in the admission test. The Ph.D/M.Phil admission test assesses the candidate's social work research aptitude. The admission test will have three components viz., written test, presentation of research proposal and personal interview as per details given below. For admission into PhD/M.Phil (SW) programme **attendance in all the components is mandatory** (**including candidates with NET and JRF**) and non-attendance in any of these would disqualify the candidature automatically. However, the Ph.D candidates who have completed M.Phil (Social Work) coursework will be exempted from appearing for written test only. All other components of admission test are mandatory even for them.
