**Subject: Engagement of Drivers on contractual basis.**

As the National Green Tribunal (NGT) is in the process of making appointments for its Principal Bench at Delhi and Zonal Benches, at Chennai etc., applications are invited for the engagement/appointment of Drivers (23 in number) on contract basis by the same procedure of recruitment as has been directed to be followed for appointments to the posts of MTS/Peons.

The contractual drivers will be given the salary equivalent to the minimum salary as prescribed under the Minimum Wages Act or the amount as payable to the drivers engaged on contractual basis in the Central Government, whichever is higher.

The willing candidates may send their application on a plain paper alongwith a recent passport size photograph supported by copies of the documents duly attested, through courier/post, so as to reach to the office of the Registrar, National Green Tribunal, Van Vigyan Bhawan, Sector-5, R.K. Puram, New Delhi-110022 latest by 7<sup>th</sup> of February, 2013 up to 5.00 p.m. The candidate should specify whether they belong to Gen/SC/OBC category. MRR is to be adopted for Reservation.

A candidate must satisfy the following conditions as on 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2013 to be eligible to apply for the said post:

1. The candidate must be a citizen of India
2. The age limit should be between the age of 18-32 years. Upper age limit is relaxable at the discretion of the Hon'ble Chairperson. The crucial date to determine the age will be 1<sup>st</sup> of January, 2013.
3. The candidate must have passed 10<sup>th</sup> or its equivalent qualification from a recognised Board or University.
4. A valid driving license to drive motor vehicle (light) shall be essential for the Applicants to be eligible.
5. The candidate having two years unblemished driving experience, shall be preferred.
6. The Driving Certificate from a Recognised Institute shall be preferable.

Incomplete, unsigned applications shall be rejected summarily without any intimation to the candidates
