ADMISSION TO M.Tech. POGRAMME 2013-14: INFORMATION SHEET

Location of the Institute

National Institute of Technology Calicut (NITC) is located in a campus near Chathamangalam, about 22 km North East of Calicut City in Kerala State. The Campus extends for a length of about 1.5 km along the Kunnamangalam – Mukkam Road and covers an area of approximately 120 hectares in a picturesque landscape at the foothills of the Western Ghats. The Institute is connected with Calicut City by KSRTC buses starting from KSRTC Central Bus Station and by private buses starting from Corporation Bus Station, Palayam (near Calicut Railway Station). Taxi fare from Calicut Station to NITC is about Rs.450/- and Auto rickshaw fare is about Rs. 300/-. The nearest airport is at Karipur near Calicut, which is 45 km from the Institute. Other nearby airports are Cochin, Trivandrum and Mangalore.

General Information

The climate at Calicut is tropical and moderate with temperature ranging from 20 to 34 degree Celsius and high humidity. Calicut experiences heavy rainfall during June to August, moderate rainfall during October-November and mild winter during December-January. Candidates are advised to bring adequate rain gear.

ATM facility is available in the campus from State Bank of India and Punjab National Bank.

Institute Fee

At the time of admission, candidates of all categories (OP, OBC, SC & ST) are required to deposit the balance Institute Fee of Rs.15,302/- by Demand Draft drawn in favour of: "The Director, NIT Calicut" payable at State Bank of India, NIT Calicut Branch (Code No. 2207).

If a candidate does not report for admission during the specified date and time, his/her candidature for admission will stand cancelled. Requests for any change of date or time of admission or request for more time to remit the fee or to produce the required documents will not be entertained.

Hostel facilities: Available for boys and girls. However, due to recent increase in seats as a result of reservation policy, hostel accommodation is subjected to availability of rooms.

Hostel fee at the time of admission is Rs **13,000/-** (inclusive of refundable caution deposit for Rs 11,000/-). Hostel room rent varies between Rs.150/- to Rs. 200/- per month (approximately). Electricity and other charges are payable every month and it will be Rs. 600/- (approximately). Mess charge (as is where basis is) is Rs.2,500/- per month (approximately). The DD for hostel fee should be drawn in favour of: "**The Chief Warden, NITC Hostels**" payable at **State Bank of India, NIT Calicut Branch (Code No. 2207)**.

Original Documents to be brought by the candidates at the time of admission:

- 1. Provisional seat allotment letter.
- 2. GATE Score Card.
- 3. Proof of Date of Birth (SSLC or equivalent Certificate).
- 4. Mark list of the qualifying examination and Degree certificate. Candidates who are appearing for their final examination and are awaiting results should produce all original mark lists up to and including seventh semester / Third Year. Such candidates will be considered for provisional admission provided they will be able to submit the original/provisional degree certificate and final marklist (satisfying the eligibility criteria) by 15th September 2013. They have to produce a certificate from the Head of the Institution stating that he/ she has appeared/appearing for the final semester / year examination of the qualifying degree.
- 5. Diploma certificate and mark sheets in case of lateral entry candidates.
- 6. Conduct/ Character certificate from the Head of the Institution/ Organization last attended/ working, issued within last six months.
- 7. Caste Certificate, in the case of SC/ST candidate, from a competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar).
- 8. Community Certificate, in the case of OBC candidate, from a competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar) indicating the status regarding Creamy Layer issued on or after **1**st **April**, **2013**.
- 9. Transfer / Leaving Certificate from the institution last attended.
- 10. Certificate from the competent authority, in the case of Physically Handicapped candidates.
- 11. Ten passport size photographs and one stamp size photograph.

If any certificate is in a language other than English/Hindi, an English version of that certificate attested by the processing center should be produced compulsorily.

Note: Copies (two numbers each) of the above certificates attested by a Gazetted Officer, are also to be brought at the time of admission. Candidates are advised to keep sufficient number of attested copies of mark lists and other certificates for their future use, if any, since all the original certificates submitted to NIT Calicut at the time of admission will be retained in the Institute till the admission process is over.

Withdrawal of candidature after taking admission in NIT Calicut is as per the existing rules of the Institute.
