Essential qualification & Experience:

- (i) MBBS degree recognized by MCI
- (ii) Eight years Clinical research experience in Medicine / Pulmonology / Chest Diseases / Pediatrics / Community Medicine in recognized institute(s) after obtaining essential qualification (i) out of which at least 2 years in a managerial position to handle R&D projects in a team effectively in a directing capacity

Desirable qualifications:

- (i) MD degree in Medicine/Pulmonology/Pediatrics/ Community Medicine/Chest Disease/ equivalent degree from a recognized university
- (ii) Additional Post doctoral research/teaching experience in the above mentioned subjects in recognized institute(s)

Job Requirements:

A scientist in this position is expected to design and develop independent research projects on thematic areas covered by National Institute for Research in Tuberculosis, Chennai in addition to participating in ongoing clinical trials and operational research studies in the fields of TB and HIV-TB co-infection. The candidate should be able to design, implement, monitor and supervise multi centric studies. Scientist will have to take primary responsibility for day to day care of trial patients as well as participate in research activities, such as data collection, management, analysis and report writing. Scientist should be willing to work in Chennai or Madurai and to travel as per job requirements. Scientist should also be prepared to undertake administrative responsibilities, as per Director's request from time to time.
