7. AN ADMISSION COMMITTEE DULY CONSTITUTED BY THE UNIVERSITY/ COLLEGE SHALL SCRUTINIZE ALL THE APPLICATIONS AND MAKE ADMISSIONS AS PER RULES IN FORCE AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION. THE DECISION OF THE ADMISSIONS COMMITTEE IS FINAL AND BINDING IN ALL MATTERS RELATED TO THE ADMISSIONS.

8 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

A. Educational Qualifications (Candidates from Industry/ Academic Institutions / R&D are preferable)

(i) For M.Tech Textile Technology (Part-Time) Course – 6 Semester (2 Year s Course work & 1 ear Project Work - 3 years)

B.Tech. (Textile Technology/ Textile Engineering/ Fibre Science & Technology/ Apparel Technology/ Fashion Technology) or GTA –Graduate course from All India Textile Assosiation,/ A.M.I.E. (Textile Engg)/ B.Sc. Home Science four Year Degree in Apparel Production Management / Fashion Technology / M.Sc Home Science in Apparels & Textiles / MSc. Home Science in Textiles & Clothing/ Any degree from Research or Industrial establishments equivalent to B.Tech Textile Technology ,situated under the Jurisdiction of Osmania University

(ii) For M.Tech Chemical Engg. (Part Time) Course - 6 Semester (2 Year s Course work & 1 ear Project Work - 3 years)

B.Tech Chemical Engg / B.E Chemical Engg/ AICHE or any other degree course equivalent to B.Tech Chemical Engg.

(iii) For M.Tech Food Technology (Part Time) Course – 6 Semester (2 Years Course work & 1 Year Project Work- 3 Years)

Candidates with B.Tech (Food Technology/Food Science & Technology/Food Engineering / Dairy Science & Technology / Dairy Technology/Food & Fermentation Technology/Oils and Fat Technology/Biotechnology/Chemical Engineering) or MSc. (Food Tech/Food Science & Technology/Food Sciences/Biotechnology/Oils and Fats) or B.Sc (Agricultural Engineering)from Research or Industrial establishments situated under recognized university.

B. Admissions to above courses will be based on the performance at the entrance test. Candidates who secure a minimum of 36% marks in the Entrance Test under General and Backward Class category and 15% marks under the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Category will be considered for admission. In case of a tie at the entrance test, date of birth will be considered and the older candidate will be considered for admission first.

9. Entrance Test to be conducted will be at Under graduate level (Refer Annexure III for Syllabus)

10. Results of Entrance Test will be displayed in University College of Technology Notice Board on 16th August, 2012 at 16.00 hrs.

11.Counselling for admission to PTPG Course offered at University College of Technology will be conducted as per the schedule mentioned at Seminar Hall, University college of Technology, Osmania University, Hyderabad. Individual communication in this regard will not be sent.

12. a) Provisional admission will be made only from among those who are eligible and

present on scheduled date and time as per the details given . Candidates have to present themselves on scheduled dates with all the original certificates and the prescribed fee thro'DD, to be considered for admission at scheduled time

b) Provisional Admission and payment of fees by selected candidates will be on the scheduled date & time. Prescribed fee should be paid in cash immediately. Non-payment of fees at the time of admission automatically results in cancellation of the offer of admission.

c) All Provisionally admitted candidates are required to register for the subjects in the college , as per the schedule to be notified on the day of counseling. Commencement of the class work will also be notified on the day of counseling.

M.Tech.(PTPG) Course 2012- 2013

d) The candidates are particularly advised to be present at the venue of admission on the scheduled day and time for admission and remain till admission process is completed. If any candidate fails to respond to the call for admission formalities, he/she forfeits claim for admission to the course.

13. Details of the number of seats, including reservations under various categories, for the academic year 2010-2011 is as follows

Total Seats : 15, OC: 8, BC: 4, SC: 2, ST: 1

14. Reservations for SC/ST/BC categories are made according to the A.P. Govt. rules in force at the time of admission.

15. Part-Time students are not eligible for Scholarships.

16 Part-Time courses are self-supporting programmes and No Hostel Accommodation is provided.

17. M.Tech (Part-Time courses) – 6-semester programme is offered only in the evening during 6.00 PM to 9.00 PM.

18. Part-Time programme in a particular specialization may not be offered if required minimum number of candidates are not qualified and seek admission for it.

19. SOME GENERAL RULES REGARDING RESERVATIONS OF SEATS

a) SC, ST & BC candidates who get seats by merit in General category will not be counted against the seats reserved for them and such candidates will go into the list of general seats.

b) If sufficient number of candidates are not available to fill up the seats reserved for SCs they shall be filled up by the suitable candidates from STs and vice-versa. If the require number of candidates are not available for filling the quota of seats reserved for SCs and STs they may be filled up by candidates from the general pool on the basis of merit.

c) For filling up the seats reserved for backward class groups - A, B, C, D & E, the guidelines provided in relevant and latest G.O. will be followed.

d) Wherever applicable, a minimum of 33.33% of the available seats in each post-graduate course will be allotted to women candidates from each category i.e., open competition, ST/SC/BC. This rule is not applicable (i) if women candidates selected on merit in each category are 33.33% or more of the seats therein; and (ii) for seats under various supernumerary categories. In the absence of suitable women candidates in the respective categories, these seats shall be filled in with men candidates of the same category.

e) Admissions under ST, SC and BC categories will be made as per the A.P. Govt. rules and regulations in force at the time of admission.

20. Fee Particulars to be paid at the time of Admission : An amount of Rs.25,000/(Rupees twenty five

thousand only) to be paid thro' Demand Draft at the time of admission by all the candidates (this includes one semester tuition fee of Rs.19,000/- and a one time fee of Rs.6,000/- towards internet, library deposit and other miscellaneous charges)

ANNEXURE – II

RULES OF ADMISSION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ANDHRA PRADESH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATIONS OF ADMISSIONS) ORDER 1974 WITH AMENDMENT IN 1975, AND 1976

1. Admissions to 85% of the available seats in every course shall be reserved in favour of Local Candidates in relation to the local area in respect of Osmania University, subject to community reservation and other non-statutory reservation made under the admission rules of the State Government.

A. LOCAL AREA

The part of the State comprising the districts of Adilabad, Hyderabad (including twin cities) Karimnagar, Khammam, Mahabubnagar, Medak, Nalgonda, Nizamabad, Rangareddy and Warangal shall be regarded as the local area for the purpose of admission to Osmania University and to any other educational institution other than state-wide Educational Institution which is subject to the control of the state Government and is situated in that part.

B. LOCAL CANDIDATE

- 1. A candidate for admission to any course of study shall be regarded as a local candidate in relation to local area :
 - i) If he has studied in an educational Institution in such local area for a period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year which he appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination.
 - ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or, as the case may be first appeared of the relevant qualifying examination he has not studied in any educational institution if he has resided in that local area for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination in which he appeared or, as the case may be, first appeared.
- 2. A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub-paragraph (1) in relation to any local area shall
 - a) If he has studied in an educational institution in the state for the period of not less than seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared or, as the case may be first appeared of the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as a local candidate in relation to :
 - i) Such local area where he has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years; of
 - ii) Where the periods of his study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he has studied last in such equal periods or
 - b) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he appeared, or as the case may be, first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination. he has not studied in the educational institutions in any local area but has resided in the state during the whole of the said period of seven years, be regarding as a local candidate in relation to :
 - i) Such local area where he has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of seven years; or
 - ii) Where the periods of his residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he has resided last in such equal periods.

- 3. The remaining 15% of the seats are open to local and non-local and shall be filled up subject to similar reservation as applicable to 85% local candidates as below:
 - a) All candidates who have studied in a recognized educational institution or institutions in the state for period of not less than four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which they appeared or as the case may be, first appeared in the relevant qualifying examination or where during the whole or any part of such four consecutive academic years, if they have not studied in any educational institutions, if they have resided in the state for a period of not less than four years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examinations.
 - b) Candidates who have resided in the state for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the state, or either of whose parents have resident in the state for a total period of ten years excluding the periods of employment outside the state.
 - c) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-public institutions within the state.
 - d) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of this State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities, and educational Institutions recognized by the Government, Universities or other competent authority and similar other quasi-Government Institutions within the State.
 - e) Candidates who are employees of the State or Central Govt. Undertaking, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-public sector institutions within State.
