Extent of Age Relaxation:

- (a) Serving Railway employees who have put in a minimum of 03 years continuous service will be given relaxation of age, subject to the age limit of 40 years for UR, 43 years for OBC and 45 years for SC/ST.
- (b) For those Quasi-Administrative offices of the Railway organization such as Railway Canteens, Cooperative Societies and institutes, the relaxation in upper age limits will be up to the length of service rendered subject to maximum 05 years.
- (c) Widows/Divorced women and women judicially separated but not remarried: UR up to 35 years, OBC – up to 38 years, SC/ST– up to 40 years.
- (d) Persons with disability:

4. EXAMINATION FEE:

 (ii) Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.

- (iii) BPL card or any other certificate issued by the central government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme or Izzat MST issued by Railways.
- (iv) Union Minister may also recommend for any persons from anywhere in the country.
- (v) Sitting members of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the district in which these MPs normally reside. This would have to be issued on the letter head of the issuing authority.

6. HOW TO APPLY:
