4. System of education

The pattern of instruction is semester course credit system with external evaluation and thesis research is essential part of all post graduate programs.

5. Minimum residential requirement

Master's Degree - Two years (Four semesters) Doctoral Degree - Three years (Six semesters)

6. Eligibility for Master/Doctoral programs

- 6.1. **Masters program**: Graduates who have completed four years degree program in any one of the State Agricultural Universities / Colleges affiliated to State Agricultural Universities alone are eligible to apply for masters.
- 6.2. Doctoral programs: Candidates who have studied four years degree program and two years masters program in any one of the State Agricultural Universities / Colleges affiliated to State Agricultural Universities alone are eligible to apply for doctoral programs.

6.3. Minimum OGPA /Aggregate requirement:

Masters / Doctoral Programs: A candidate who has undergone course credit system with a minimum OGPA of 3.00 out of 4.00 or 7.00 out of 10.00 or 70% aggregate alone is eligible to apply for various Masters and Ph.D. programs. However, for SC/ST candidates a pass in the qualifying degree is sufficient for all programs.

8. Method of selection

For all Masters / Doctoral programs

8.1. Candidates shall be required to be present on the specified date for a written test to be conducted at TNAU, Coimbatore at their own expenses. Request for change in the date/time will not be entertained.

- 8.2. The exact date of written test will be hosted in the University website and intimated to the candidate through email.
- 8.3. Written test with objective type questions from concerned subject will be of one hour duration. Candidates applied for two subjects should write the examination for both subjects continuously for two hours.
- 8.4. The students are ranked based on total marks obtained by them. The distribution of marks is furnished below.

- 8.7. Allotment of students to the different Agricultural Colleges (for course and thesis) / Research Stations (for thesis) of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University is left entirely to the discretion of the University.
- 8.8. Seats are reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (including Arunthathiars)/Scheduled Tribes/ Most Backward/Backward Class Muslim/ Backward Classes as prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu.

9. Admission Procedure

- 9.1. The candidate will be informed of their selection for admission to PG programs by email only. List of selected candidates will be hosted in the website also. University will not hold any responsibility for failure in delivery of mails. They should pay the prescribed fees on or before the date specified by the Dean, School of Post graduate Studies, failing which their names will be deleted from the selection list and the resultant vacancies will be filled up from the wait list.
- 9.2. The following original documents must be surrendered at the time of admission and failure to surrender any of the documents will make the candidates ineligible for admission.
 - i. Provisional / Degree certificate of Bachelor's / Master's degree
 - ii. Transfer /Migration certificate
 - iii. Conduct certificates one from the head of the Institution and two from the Professors of the Institution where the candidate last studied.
 - iv. Mark list/transcript card of Bachelor's/Master's degree.
 - v. The original community certificate issued by the competent Revenue authorities should be produced for verification. An attested copy of original community certificate should be submitted for record.
- 9.3. Candidates who have paid the fees should register their courses on the date specified or within 7 working days (Inclusive of Saturdays) from commencement of semester failing which the candidates will have to forfeit their seat.
- 9.4. Selected candidates who pay the fees on the notified date but fail to register on the specified date or fail to inform within seven working days from the date specified for

registration are liable to forfeit all fees paid.

- 9.5. Candidates who discontinue after admission (or) registering the courses are not eligible for refund of any other fees except caution money deposits.
- 9.6. Once the originals are surrendered they will not be returned to the candidates till the course is completed or the candidates discontinue the course permanently. Hence, sufficient number of the copies of all the original certificates (Grade/Mark sheet/report cards/ transfer/ conduct/provisional degree certificates) should be taken by the candidates before surrendering the originals to the University.

10. Purchase of Laptop computer

It is compulsory that all PG students should purchase laptop computer with configuration prescribed by TNAU to be proficient in soft skills and communicate on line and to write mid-term examination online. Wifi internet facilities are available in the hostels.

11. Intimation of entrance test/selection/admission

All communications regarding entrance test/selection / admission will be notified only electronically by e-mail and hence, candidates are requested to provide E-mail ID compulsorily and check their e-mails daily. Important dates/Notification will be posted on TNAU website.

12. Hostel Accommodation

Limited hostel facilities are available. The University will provide accommodation to the extent possible, on first come first served basis. Students can not claim hostel accommodation as a right over admission to PG program. University reserves the right to provide/deny hostel accommodation to the student.

13. **Dispute Redressal**

Any complaints, grievances etc., related to PG admission 2012-2013 and academic matters must be first referred to the Dean, School of Post Graduate Studies, Coimbatore who will be the appellate authority with respect to such complaints/disputes. The Courts having their jurisdiction at Coimbatore alone can adjudicate on all matters and disputes related to PG admission 2012-2013 and academic matters.

14. Important: Ragging is an offence. Students indulging in ragging either inside or outside college will be prosecuted as per rules.
