Research Eligibility Test (RET).

- 1. 4 (Four) vacancies exist in the Department for admission to Ph.D considering the strength and availability of faculty members.
- 2. The **Research Eligibility Test (RET)** for Ph.D. programme in Genetics & Plant Breeding will be held on **7th February**, **2012 at 2 p.m.**
- 3. The last date for submission of application form :30th January, 2012.
- 4. The **RET** will be of 50 marks . The question pattern will be of multiple choice type or short answer type . The Duration of the entrance test will be one hour.
- 5. An interview will be held on 14th th February, 2012 at 2 p.m. for **RET** qualified (Qualification bench mark – 40% of the total marks) as well as NET/GATE/ SLET qualified candidates.
- 6. Successful candidates will be eligible to register for their Ph.D in Department of Genetics & Plant Breeding .

7. Eligibility :

The Ph.D. entrance test of 50 marks for the eligible candidates will be held twice (depending on the availability of candidate) in a year and the qualifying marks will be fixed at 40%. Candidates with at least 50% Marks obtained in M.Sc. (Ag.) in Genetics & Plant Breeding (or allied disciplines subject to endorsement by the concerned Ph.D. Committee) from any UGC recognized University are eligible to appear in the Examination. Those who have qualified NET/GATE/SLET or already obtained M.Phil degree would be exempted from the examination. They may directly submit a statement of purpose or research in brief and appear in the interview.

- SYLLABUS OF RET will be the same as for the M.A. /M.Sc. and UGC-NET • Examination in Archaeology.
