REVISED ADMISSION NOTIFICATION FOR 3 YEAR LL.B.COURSE OF STUDIES (2014-16)

In connection to the earlier notification, dated 26.11.2013 regarding admission to 3-years LL.B. Course of Studies (academic session 2014-2016), applications in prescribed form along with the Hall Ticket, to be downloaded from the website of the University of Burdwan (www.buruniv.ac.in), from 02.12.2013 to 03.01.2014, are invited for admission to the 3-year LL.B. Course of Studies (academic session 2014-2016). The downloaded application form must accompany a) a Demand Draft of Rs. 450/- (Rupees four hundred fifty only) in favour of the 'Finance Officer, The University of Burdwan', payable at State bank of India, Burdwan University branch, b) Self attested photo copies of mark-sheets of the relevant examinations and age proof certificate, c) Certificates of S.C./ S.T./O.B.C./P.H., if any, if the candidate intends to claim reservation under Government rules.

<u>Place of Study</u>: The University of Burdwan, Hooghly Mohsin College and Self-Financing Private Law Colleges affiliated to the University of Burdwan: i) Bengal Law College, Shantiniketan; ii) Durgapur Institute of Legal Studies, Durgapur; iii) Law College, Durgapur.

<u>Eligibility</u>: A candidate is eligible to apply for admission into the course if he/she secures not below 45% of the total marks in case of General category and 40% of the total marks in case of SC/ST/OBC category at the Bachelor's Degree examination under 10+2+3 pattern.

Age: The maximum age of the candidate seeking admission into the course is limited to 30 years in case of General Category and 35 years in case of SC, ST and Other Backward Communities as on 1st January 2014.

Reservation: As per Govt. rules.

Mode of Selection for Admission:

The selection for admission to the course shall be made strictly on the basis of performance of the eligible candidates at the written admission test to be conducted by the University on 12.01.2014 from 11 a.m. at Golapbag Campus of the University (Auditorium Hall). For selection a candidate has to secure the following minimum qualifying marks in the admission test: 20 for General Category candidates and 18 for SC / ST/ OBC Category candidates. Admission Test shall be of 100 marks consisting General English & General Knowledge.

<u>Publication of the merit list</u>: The short merit list of the candidates will be published on 28/01/2014. The rank of the candidates will be made on the basis of the marks obtained in the written test. In case of the uniform score of the candidates in the written test, preference will be given to the candidates having Honours Degree than Pass Graduates. In case of the uniform score in the concerned Honours Degree, the percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in Higher Secondary Examination will be considered and calculated for determining the higher position in the merit list. And if the percentage of Higher Secondary marks appears to be the same, percentage of Secondary Examination will be considered for ranking.

*** There shall be no counseling for admission. At the time of submission of the application form, all the candidates have to exercise their options with regard to the choice of place of studies mandatorily in the column printed in the application form. The short list of candidates for admission to the colleges will be published on the basis of their choice and respective rank in the merit list and the same will remain valid for 05 (five) working days for admission from the date of publication of the said short list.

Last date of submission of filled-up form and Hall Ticket at the Office of the Secretary, Faculty Council (Arts etc.), Rajbati, Burdwan: 03.01.2014.
