Send the filled in application form with all the enclosures by Speed Post / Courier or deliver personally to the **Director, Mysore University School of Justice, (Law Department Building), Manasagangothri, Mysore – 570006**, so as to reach him on or **before 29-06-2013, by 5 P.M.** Applications received after the last date will be rejected.

7. The Admission Test is of 60 minutes duration with mostly objective type questions to test the general knowledge, general English, Arithmetic and aptitude for legal studies of students at the level of 10+2 school examination.
