



YVUCET- 2013 for Admission into 5 Year Integrated M.Sc. Courses, Bachelor of Fine Arts, PG Diploma in Theatre Arts

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

A. GENERAL

1. Directorate of Admissions, Yogi Vemana University, Kadapa invites applications for admission into **5 Year Integrated M.Sc Courses in Biotechnology & Bioinformatics, Earth Sciences, Bachelor of Fine Arts and PG Diploma in Theatre Arts** Offered at Yogi Vemana University College during the academic year 2013-14.
2. The admissions are governed by the YVUCET- 2013 rules and regulations as given below. The Advisory Committee of YVUCET-2013 reserves the right to change or modify the rules.
3. For getting admission into **5 Year Integrated M.Sc Courses and Bachelor of Fine Arts**, any candidate should qualify in YVUCET-2013 and satisfy the eligibility criteria prescribed for course. No candidate will be admitted by the university without rank in YVUCET-2013. However, **candidates applied for PG Diploma in Theatre Arts**, will be admitted directly without entrance test.
4. No candidate is entitled to pursue more than one full time course at a time. If admitted, no candidate can undertake any other assignment or employment or study any other course simultaneously with the exception of evening courses offered by the University
5. University reserves the right to run or not to run a particular course based on the economic viability depending on the number of candidates who opt to join in it.
6. **Qualifying in the YVUCET-2013 does not guarantee admission.** The candidate must satisfy all the eligibility criteria prescribed for the course.
7. If it is proved that any of the certificates submitted by a candidate was tampered or fake, the candidate not only loses seat but is also liable for prosecution.
8. Notwithstanding anything in this booklet, the rules and regulations that are in force in the University from time - to - time are applicable.

C. ELEGIBILITY FOR WRITING THE ENTRANCE TEST

1. The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination with a minimum of 50% marks. For admission into PG Diploma in Theatre Arts which is based on the degree as a whole, the aggregate percentage in the group subject should be 50% of marks.

Pass is sufficient for SC/ST candidates for admission into any course.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR DIFFERENT COURSES

D. HOW TO APPLY

1. Candidate has to submit a separate application for each Course.
2. Application form and the brochure can be purchased from the Office of Directorate Of Admissions, Yogi vema University, Kadapa in person or by post by sending a self addressed stamped Envelope (Rs. 30/-) of the size 40x30cm along with demand draft (DD) for Rs.350/- drawn on a nationalized bank in favour of The Convenor, YUCET-2013 payable at State Bank of

India, Y.V. University Campus Branch (10109), Kadapa with the name and address of the applicant clearly written on the reverse side of the DD.

3. The duly filled-in application should be accompanied with the following enclosures :
 - a. Acknowledgement card stamped for Rs.5/- with self address
 - b. Three envelopes for Hall Ticket, Rank Card and Counseling Memo duly stamped for Rs. 5/- each
 - c. Xerox copies of :
 - Date of birth extract/SSC
 - Evidence for claims of reservation under Caste/PH/NCC/NSS/Games & Sports/CAP etc.
 - Marks statement of qualifying examination
4. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE SUMMARILY REJECTED

F. LATE APPLICATIONS

Applications can be accepted up to 29-06-2013 with a late fee of Rs. 250/- through DD in favour of The Convenor, YVUCET-2013

G. HALL TICKETS

1. Hall tickets for the entrance test will be sent to the candidates to the given address.
2. In case of non receipt of original Hall Ticket, Duplicate hall ticket can be had from the office of the Director,DOA, YVU or from the Chief Superintendent of the Examination center by submitting an attested passport size photograph and a demand draft for Rs. 100/- drawn in favour of **The Convenor,YVUCET-2013** along with evidence of having submitted the application.
3. YVUCET-2013 hall ticket is to be preserved carefully and produced at the time of admission.

H. PARTICULARS OF ENTRANCE TESTS

1. There is a prescribed syllabus for each entrance test as given in Sections of the entrance test consists of Section A for 25 marks, Section B for 25 marks and Section C for 50 marks.

2. Each entrance test will be of 90 minutes duration with 100 multiple choice type questions. Each question carries one mark.
3. For all entrance tests, the question papers will be in both English and Telugu.
4. No candidate will be permitted into the examination hall without proper hall ticket.
5. Calculators, books, papers, mathematical and physical tables, slide rules, pagers, electronic organizers, digital diaries, cellular phones or any other calculating aids are not allowed into the examination hall.
6. Candidate should answer only in the OMR SHEET / ANSWER BOOKLET provided to him/her hall ticket number and photo printed on it.

I. RANKING

1. The minimum marks for qualifying in the entrance test is 35. However, for SC/ST candidates there is no minimum qualifying marks
2. When there is a tie on the basis of marks obtained in the test as a whole, it will be resolved on the basis of marks obtained in Section C. If there is still a tie, it will be resolved on the basis of marks obtained in Section B. If there is still a tie, it will be resolved as per seniority in age.
3. Rank cards will be posted to the candidates after the publication of YVUCET-2013 results and the same will be posted on YVU WEB SITE immediately.
4. The rank obtained in YVUCET-2013 is valid for admission for the academic year 2013-14 only.
5. There is no provision for REVALUATION or PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION of answer sheet.
6. The results of the entrance test will be displayed on the Notice Board at the Directorate of Admissions. The Directorate is not responsible for loss of the Rank Card or Postal Delay.

J. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admissions are based on the YVUCET-2013 rank, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility criteria.
2. The candidate should have passed the qualifying examination with minimum percentage of marks as mentioned in Section C when he/she is called for the counseling for admission, failing which the qualified candidate next in rank would be admitted.
3. Admission into each course will be done by calling at least three candidates for every seat in each category. Candidates have to attend the counseling at the allotted venue, date and time at their own expenses with the required documents and fees.
4. If a candidate fails to attend the counseling at the specified date and time for whatever reason (including non-receipt or delayed receipt of call letter), he/she will forfeit the seat and the candidate next in rank will be considered for admission. Any representation for postponement of the date and time of personal appearance will not be entertained.

5. Late comers for the counseling on the scheduled date will be considered for the available vacancies only.
6. If a candidate reports himself/herself after the counseling is over with some valid reason, such a candidate on written representation may be considered for admission into the course if only there is a vacancy in the particular category for which he/she is eligible.
7. At the time of counseling, the following original documents should be submitted by the candidate: YVUCET-2013 Rank Card and Hall Ticket.
 - ❖ Marks statements and Provisional/Degree Certificate of the qualifying examination
 - ❖ Transfer and Conduct Certificates (Admission will not be given if T.C. of the candidate last studied is not submitted)
 - ❖ SSC and Intermediate pass certificates
 - ❖ Six Passport size photographs
 - ❖ Study Certificates from IX Class to qualifying examination
 - ❖ Caste Certificate in original from the Tahshildar in case of SC/ST/BC candidates (integrated caste certificate or one taken in 2013)
 - ❖ Two income certificates from the Tahshildar obtained in 2013 (for fee concession)
 - ❖ Relevant certificate in case of other reservations (PH/NCC/NSS/Games & Sports/Cultural Activity)
 - ❖ Discharge Certificate and Service Certificate of the parent in case of a child of armed person. Residence Certificate of parents for stay in the state of A.P. from Tahshildar in case of candidatea who have studied outside A.P./carried out private study.
 - ❖ Migration certificate (for other University candidates)
8. The cases of pending revaluation will not be considered.
9. Admission will be finalized on the day of counseling on the basis of rank obtained in the entrance test and fulfillment of eligibility criteria subject to rules of reservation. Candidate who can not produce all the necessary certificates at the time of counseling will forfeit admission. If selected, the candidate has to pay the prescribed fees immediately.
10. Cancellation of admissions is allowed with a cancellation fee of 10% of the regular or self financing fee paid or Rs.500/- whichever is more until the commencement of second phase of counseling and without refund of fee from the date of commencement of second phase of counseling until the closing of admissions.
11. For cancellation of admission after the closing of admissions, one has to pay the total fee for the entire course period without concession and get back the original certificates.
12. All the admissions are purely provisional, and the University reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage.

K. LOCAL AND NON-LOCAL CANDIDATES

1. The Y.V.University area comprises of the districts of Kadapa, Kurnool, Chittoor, Nellore & Anantapur. The following candidates are treated as local to Y.V.University area.
 - a) A candidate who has studied in the Y.V.University area (or stayed in case of private study) for four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she has first appeared for the final year qualifying examination.
 - b) A candidate who has studied (or stayed in case of private study) for equal periods in the Y.V.University area and another University area out of the last seven years, he/she should have studied (or stayed in case of private study) lastly in the Y.V.University area.
2. Any candidate who is not local to Y.V.University is treated as non-local. If
 - a) He/she is local to any other University in Andhra Pradesh State.
 - b) He/she resided for a total period not less than 10 years in Andhra Pradesh (excluding the periods of study outside the State).
 - c) His/her parents has resided in Andhra Pradesh for total period not less than 10 years.
 - d) His/her parent/spouse is currently working in Andhra Pradesh in government or allied service.

L. ALLOCATION OF SEATS TO VARIOUS RESERVATION CATEGORIES

1. Among the seats sanctioned in each course, 85% of the seats in each course are filled with reserved categories of local candidates, while 15% are filled with local or non-local candidates on merit.
2. Seats allocated for different reserved categories are as follows: SC-15%, ST-6%, BCA-7%, BCB-10%, BCC-1%, BCD-7%, BCE-4%, NCC-1%, NSS-1%, Cultural Activities-1%, Games and Sports-1%, PH(Physically handicapped)-3% and CAP (Children of Armed Personnel)-2%.
3. Reservation for women : 33.33% of the seats are reserved for women candidates in each category (i.e, OPEN, SC,ST, BC, ECA, PH and L/NL), This rule is not applied if woman candidates selected on merit in a category from one third or more of the seats therein. If there are no suitable women candidates in a category, the seats will be filled with men candidates of the same category.
4. A vacancy under SC goes to ST and vice-versa. If enough SC&ST candidates are not available, the left-over seats will go to OC.
5. A vacancy under one BC group goes to any other BC group on the basis of entrance rank. If enough BC candidates are not available, the left-over seats will go to OC.
6. Extracurricular Activities (ECA) Seats
Candidates proficient in the categories namely NCC, NSS, Games & Sports and Cultural Activities and Local to Y.V. University are eligible for the ECA seats.

Participation during the period of study of the qualifying examination is alone considered

Priority I : International level participation in NCC.

International level participation in NCC activities.

International participation in approved World competitions/ World competitions for Juniors/World University Competitions in the order.

International level participation in Youth Festival

Priority II : National level participation in NCC

National level participation in NSS activities

National championship/ Junior National championship/ South Zone championship participation in Games & Sports in the order.

National level participation in Youth Festival with prize.

Priority III : State level participation in NCC or just C or B certificate holders.

State or Inter-university NSS camps or NSS two Special camps

Inter-University/Inter District/Inter Collegiate participation in Games & Sports in the order.

South Zone level participation in Youth festival (Priority for prize winners)

7. Under Games & Sports Category, participation in the following games and sports only shall be considered as certified by recognized bodies or associations: Cricket, Foot Ball, Hockey, Volley Ball, Basket Ball, Tennis, Kabadi, Shuttle- Badminton, Ball-Badminton, Table Tennis, Athletics, Swimming, Weight Lifting, Wrestling, Boxing, Gymnastics, Kho-Kho, Hand Ball, Chess, Cycling, Rowing, Body Building and Shooting. Candidate shall have to produce the following documents
 - a. Certificates issued by a recognized Sports Body or Association
 - b. Group photos or paper cuttings, if any as a proof of participation of the candidate in the sports or games events.
8. ECA general merit list will be prepared with candidates of Priority I arranged in the order of YVUCET- 2013 rank followed by candidates of Priority II arranged in the order of YVUCET-2013 rank followed by candidates of Priority III arranged in the order of YVUCET-2013 rank.
 - I. When there is only one ECA seat in a course, it will be filled as per the order in the ECA general merit list.
 - II When there are two ECA seats, the first seat will be filled as per the order in the ECA general merit list. And the second seat will be filled from the ECA general merit list by a candidate belonging to the category other than the category of the first candidate selected ensuring women reservation
 - III. When there are three ECA seats, one seat is earmarked of each category. The seat will be filled as per the order in the ECA general merit list. The second seat will be filled from ECA general merit list by a candidate not belonging to the ECA general merit list by candidate belonging to the remaining category ensuring women reservation. The left-over ECA Seats will go to Open Category.

9. Physically Handicapped (PH) Category :

- I PH candidates should enclose the attested copy of the certificate issued by the Medical Board of District Headquartes Hospital or General Hospital of a Medical College. The Certificate should indicate the nature and extent of disability in percentage.
- II. At the time of interview, a physically handicapped candidate must submit the original PH certificate and appear before the University Doctor of YV University. Admission will be made on the basis of the percentage of disability as assessed by the University Doctor, but not according to the rank in the entrance test. Where handicap is equal, merit in the entrance test will be taken into considration for admission. A physically handicapped candidtate will not be admitted into a course if the handicap does not allow him to pursue the course to a reasonable extent. If there is no suitable candidate under PH category, the seat will be filled with a candidate of local open category.

10. Children of the Armed Personnel (CAP) category :

The following priorities shall be drawn up with regard to the children of armed personnel.

- i. Children of Servicemen killed in action.
- ii. Children of Ex-Servicemen disabled in action and permanently incapacitated as a result thereof in respect of disability person.
- iii Children of Ex-servicemen and Servicemen who have received Gallantry Award in the following order. (a) Param Vir Chakra: (b) Ashok Chakra: (c) Mahaver Chakra (d) Kirti Chakra: (e) Vir Chakra : f) Shaurya Chakra: (g) Sena/Nao Sena/Vayu Sena Medal: (h) Mention in dispatches.
- iv Children of Armed personnel (combatant) irrespective of the rank held by them.
- v Children of other Ex-Servicemen or Servicemen who are eligible for pension. If there is more than one candidate in any of the above groups, priority will be decided on the basis of YVUCET-2013 Rank

M. FEE PARTICULARS

Each admitted candidate has to pay the fee immediately in the Stae Bank of India, Y.V.U. Campus Branch. In addition to the course fee, an additional amount of Rs. 100/- (Rs.50/- for SC/ST) is to be paid towards counseling fee.

Fee concession is allowed to SC/ST/BC candidates for regular and self financing courses on production of valid caste and income certificates as per the G.O.s in vogue.

If any admitted BC/SC/ST category candidate does not get fee reimbursement from the Government, he/she will have to pay the specified fee to the University. Or if the government reimburses only part of the fee, the student has to pay the remaining fee.

For withdrawal from any regular or self-financing course after the closing of admissions, one has to pay the total course fee without concessions and get back the original certificates.
