- 1. Place of posting: JRFs may be posted in any of the Centres of Zoological Survey of India located at Calicut, Chennai, Canning, Digha, Dehradun, Gopalpur, Hyderabad, Itanagar, Jodhpur, Jabalpur, Kolkata, Patna, Pune, Port Blair, Solan and Shillong.
- 2. The upper age limit is 28 years as on date of publication of this advertisement. The age limit may be relaxed up to 5 years, as in case of candidates belonging to SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates.
- 3. Junior Research Fellows will be appointed initially for a period of two years and if found suitable may be appointed further.
