**Sub: First and Second Year M.Ed Degree Examination Oct- 2014.**

01. The M.Ed Degree Examination for the students of Karnataka State Open University Second Year 2012-13 Batch and First Year M.Ed 2013-14 Batch (All repeaters 2011-12 onwards) scheduled to be held in the month of October-2014.
- 02 **Examination shall be conducted at the following places.**
- 1) Mysore      2) Bangalore      3) Dharwad      4) Mangalore
- 03 Students are hereby informed to write their names legibly as given at the time of Admission.
- 04 **For all the repeaters, Examination shall be conducted at Mysore Centre only.**
- 05 The exact venue and dates of the examination will be notified in the Time-Table sent along with this circular.
- 06 The last dates for payment of the examination Fee and submission of examination application form by the students to University without penal fee and with penal fee are as follows.

(a) Without Penal fee	: 18.08.2014
(b) With Penal fee of Rs. 200/-	: 28.08.2014

- 08 **Examination will commence from 06<sup>th</sup> October 2014**
- 09 Students are allowed to write examination either in English or Kannada.
- 10 Examination Fee once paid shall not be refunded or adjusted.
- 11 The examination application is sent herewith. The payment of Examination fee should be paid through bank challan either in SBM/SBI. Send the Challan along with the Examination application form to the office of the Registrar(Evaluation), Karnataka State Open University Mukthagangothri, Mysore-06. The students of earlier batches shall send the attested copies of the earlier marks cards along with the application.
- 12 **The application received after the last date will not be considered.**
- 13 **Admission tickets will not be sent to the candidates by post. It shall be collected by the candidates in person at the examination centre two days prior to the commencement of Examination by producing the identity card for verification. The identity card shall also be produced in the examination hall on demand.**
- 14 Students have to enter the Roll Number at the top portion of the examination form.
- 15 Incomplete applications shall be rejected without any correspondence.
- 16 Only bank Challan will be accepted towards Examination fee

- 17 Mere payment of tuition fee, examination fee and submission of application for the examination do not entitle the student to take the examination if his/her admission is not approved by the University.
- 18 Students belonging to SC/ST and the reserved categories are also required to pay the examination fee in full as mentioned above
- 19 A candidate declared to have passed M.Ed degree Examination is permitted to reappear for the examination without rejecting the result so obtained for the purpose of improving the result and finally choose the marks/results to his/her advantage provided that:
- A) The application for such reappearance shall be made at least 60 days before the commencement of the examination.
- B) The candidate shall take the examination as per the syllabus and scheme of examination in force on the date of such subsequent appearance.
- C) The candidate cannot avail himself/herself of this facility after he/she takes the M.Ed Degree Certificate or even applies for it. Provisional Certificate taken if any must be surrendered with the application for reappearance.
- D) Such of the students who wish to take the examination for improvement of their result shall pay the examination fee of Rs.1000/- for first year and Rs.1000/- for second year respectively for taking improvement examination, only after getting permission from the University. The improvement Examination Fee of Rs.1200/- is also to be paid in addition to the examination Fee. Application for taking improvement examination will be supplied on request.
- 20 Students who have not attended the contact programme or not submitted the Assignments or not taken the tests are not eligible to take the examination even if they have paid the examination fee.
- 21 Second year M.Ed students who have not submitted the Dissertation report are not eligible to take the examination even if they have paid the examination fee.
- 22 The application forms of M.Ed students if not countersigned by the study Centre Co-ordinator will be rejected and candidate will not be permitted to appear for the examination.
- 23 Students who have not submitted the Dissertation report are hereby informed to pay Rs.200/- and submit the Dissertation report compulsorily.
- 24 Last date for submission of Dissertation for second year all freshers and repeaters without penal fee is 12th September 2014 and with penal fee of Rs. 200/- is 30<sup>th</sup> September-2014.
