
The Reserve Bank of India with an aim for spreading awareness regarding financial matters and promotion of better understanding of monetary and economic issues has launched a National Level Competition titled "The RBI Policy Challenge" targeted at Under Graduate and Post Graduate Students of Universities/Colleges/Institutes of Excellence in the country

This will be a three-tier competition to test essay-writing, problem solving and presentation skills of the participants. The regional round would involve writing the essay by students in group of 3 or 4. Only one entry per institution will be accepted. Team writing the best essay in the regional round will be selected (duly accessed by the experts) and will be sent for the Zonal round. The Zonal round competition will be held on March 9, 2016 at Kolkata, where a team will be expected to make a presentation of 15 minutes on their approach to a given problem, based on a monetary/economic issue, before a panel of experts. The best team from the Zonal Round would advance to the National Round to be held in the last week of March, 2016 at Mumbai. Winners of each round will be given cash award

The details of the Regional Round 'The RBI Policy Challenge' competition (ESSAY) are given below:


1. Topic for the essay: Demographic profile of India: Opportunity or Threat?
2. Language: English
3. Length of the Essay: Maximum 2000 words (Strictly adhered to the word limit)
4. Submission date: Within January 28, 2016 in both soft (PDF version) and hard form (It should be ensured that the details of the team concerned may be mentioned only in the Title/ First page and nowhere else.
5. Assessment Criteria:
 - Language and presentation: 30
 - Content and originality: 30
 - Quality of recommendations/suggestions: 40

7. Team: This would involve writing an essay by students in groups of 3 or 4.
8. Only one entry from Ravenshaw University will be selected after duly accessed by the judge(s) and will be sent for the consideration of Regional Round. The decision of the judge(s) will be final.

Students interested to participate are required to make their team (3 or 4 students in a team) and submit their essay as per the instructions mentioned above on or before January 28, 2016.
