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DETAILS FOR PHYSICAL ENDURANCE

Maximum Marks: 100

Pass Marks : 60

Following five tests shall be carried out in sequence:

1. **Running** : The candidates are required to complete 100 meters Running in 15 seconds failing which they will be disqualified.

2. **Rope climbing**

Height of rope : 08 meter
Size of rope : 05cm < D < 10cm

3. **Pole Climbing**

Height of pole : 08 meter
Size of pole : 10cm < D < 20cm

4. **Casualty Lifting : Description**

Objective → To assess stamina, agility and safety consciousness.
→ A sand bag of 50 kgs weight.

TEST

Lifting of a sand bag of 50 kgs by the candidate and to carry it 25 meters away and bring it back safely.

5. **LADDER CLIMBING TEST**

Objective → To check fearlessness at height.
→ To check understanding capability.

EQUIPMENT

A ladder to be properly trained at height of 06 meters from ground level

PROCEDURE:

- a) Examiner shall check stability, strength and training angle of ladder.
- b) Arrange a Fire Crew of 3-4 men to hold ladder at base and top.
- c) Demonstrate step by step the method of climbing. Then ask candidates to proceed.

NORMS FOR CONDUCTING DRIVING TEST

Driving test will comprise of three parts, as under:-

PART – I

Job Knowledge

Knowledge of vehicle and road discipline. The candidate will be asked to explain the use of major components of a vehicle e.g. radiator, injectors, fuel injection pump, dynamo, battery, tyre pressures, fan belt, safe air pressure, oil in brakes / clutch cylinders, oil in engine and level/dip stick. Difference in diesel and petrol engines, airlock and its removal, traffic signals, action to be taken in case of accident etc.

PART – II

Checking

. The candidate is supposed to check the following:

1. Radiator water level
2. Fan Belt
3. Battery water level
4. Tyre pressure visually
5. Gear
6. Brakes
7. Clutch

PART – III

Driving

Test will be conducted as per the layout given below. 9 Drums have to be placed in a specific manner as per layout for guidance. The distance between Drum 1 and Drum 2 will be $2\frac{1}{2}$ times of the width of the vehicle, $2\frac{1}{2} W$. Distance between drum 7 & 8 will be $4 W$ and drum 7,3 W from central line. Drum 3 will be 25 meters from drum 6 and $2 W$ from central line. Drum 4 & 5 will also be 24 meters from drum 6. Around drum 6, there will be a circle of 10 meters Dia for guidance. (W being the width of the vehicle).

Drive the vehicle, starting from drum 1, turn left after drum No. 3, make a U turn around drum 6 & 10 meters guide circle, and with drum No.4 and drum No.5. Follow the centerline, turn around drum No 7 towards left and stop near drum No. 9 Then reverse around drum No.8 towards drum

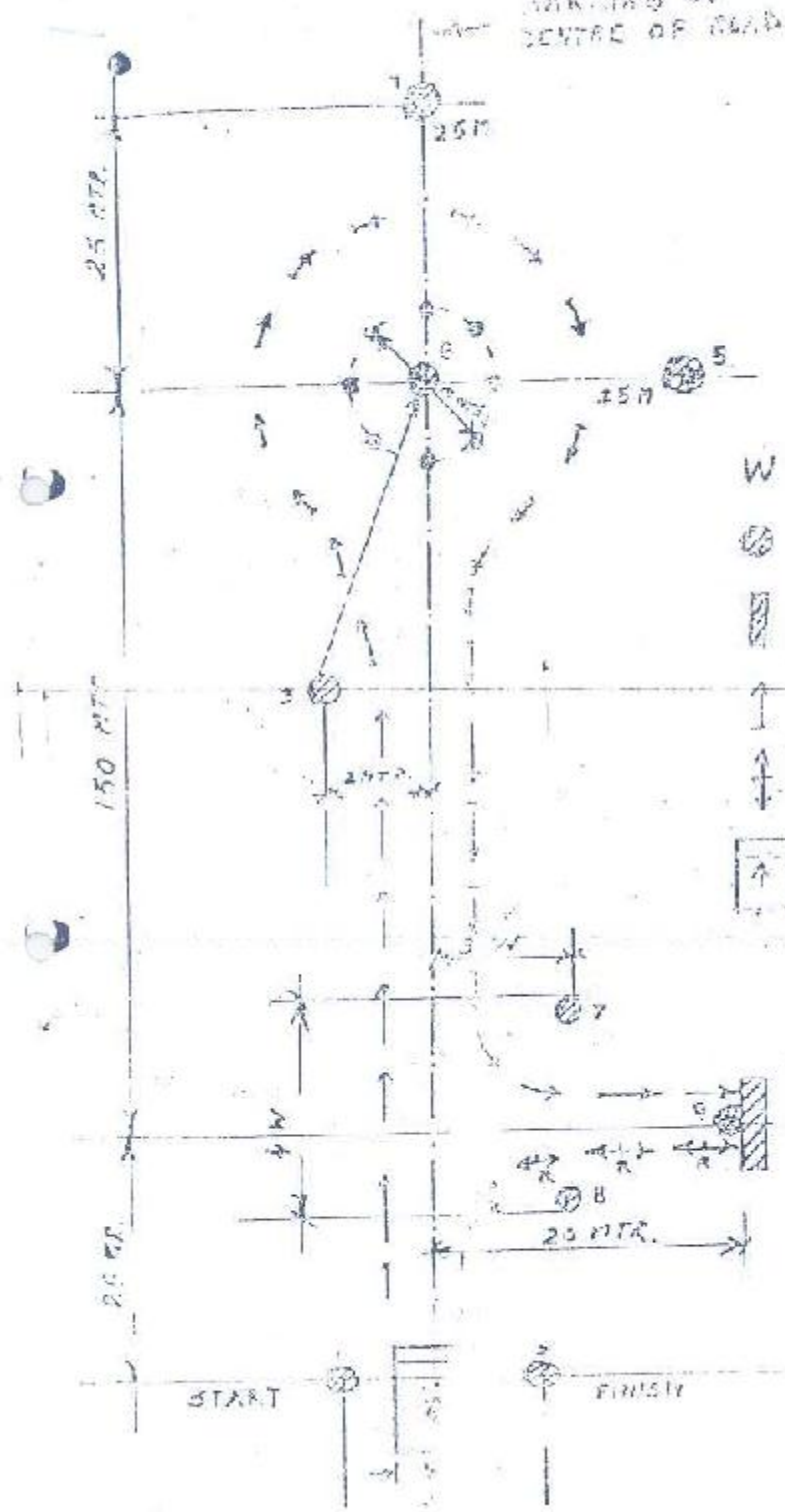
No. 2 and park the vehicle between drum No. 1 and No. 2. During the test, vehicle should not touch any drum or any guidelines around drum No. 6.
