

## Examination centre

**Candidates who have opted for Warangal as the test centre have been allotted Hyderabad and those who have opted for Vishakhapatnam have been allotted Vijayawada as the test centre.**

### Entrance Examination Timings

**The SPMVPGCET examination will be held in all the four centres Hyderabad, Vijayawada, Kurnool and Tirupati from 10Am to 11.30Am. Candidates are requested to go through the Instructions to candidates placed on this website and also printed on the hall ticket.**

## SPMVPGCET - 2013

### INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

1. The candidate will not be admitted into the examination hall without Hall Ticket.
2. The Hall Ticket should be retained carefully and to be produced at the time of counseling.
3. The candidate should be present in the examination hall half an hour before the commencement of the test.
4. The candidate will not be admitted into the examination hall after 15 minutes of the commencement of the test and will not be allowed to leave the examination hall within 45 minutes from the commencement of the test.
5. The candidate has to mark all answers only in the OMR answer sheet with HB pencil. Answers marked on the question paper booklet will not be valued.
6. The candidate must bring HB pencil, eraser and sharpener to the examination hall.
7. Adoption of any kind of unfair means at the time of examination or taking part in any act of impersonation will result in the cancellation of the candidature. The decision of the Chief Superintendent of the examination center shall be final in these matters.
8. The answer sheet will not be valued if any irrelevant matter or symbols, words, prayers or any communication whatsoever is written any where on the answer sheet or question paper booklet.
9. Any correction or overwriting of the Hall Ticket number on the OMR sheet or question paper booklet has to be attested by the Assistant Superintendent, otherwise the answer sheet will not be valued.
10. Issue of Hall Ticket and appearance at the SPMVPGCET - 2013 do not automatically entitle the candidate for admission into any course, unless the eligibility conditions are satisfied.
11. Calculators, books, papers, mathematical and physical tables, slide rules, pagers, cellular phones, digital diaries, electronic organizers or any other calculating aids will not be allowed into the examination hall.
12. The candidate is advised to follow the instructions and practice on the sample OMR sheet printed in the last page of the Instruction Booklet supplied with the application before attending the entrance test.

**Note : The candidate, at the time of test, is advised to correct the mistakes (if any) in his/her details in the nominal rolls.**
