It is, therefore, in the interest of the candidates concerned to contact immediately the respective Regional Offices of the Commission in all such cases where they do not belong to the categories shown against their roll numbers.

4. Answer keys of Paper-I were placed on the website of the Commission on <u>3.9.2013</u>. In response to that, <u>sixty nine</u> representations were received which were carefully examined and answer keys were modified accordingly. The modified answer keys were used for evaluation.
