1) "All" means OC, BC, SC and ST category candidates. 2) BC-E Reservation is subject to court judgment.

Fee Particulars: (no fee exemption for all as this is diploma course).

Rs.30,000/- for non-sponsored candidates + Rs. 800/- towards counseling fee.
Rs.70,000/- for sponsored candidates * + Rs.800/- towards counseling fee.

* The candidates, who are being sponsored by medical institutions/Hospitals/diagnostic labs/firms dealing with radio therapy equipment or such other organizations, must bring a letter of sponsorship from the concerned organization.

Fee should be paid by **Demand Draft** drawn in favour of " **Director, Directorate of Admissions, O.U. " payable at Hyderabad.** The total fee must be paid immediately on the day of counseling. Arrangements are being made at the venue for obtaining Demand Draft for the requisite fee.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The candidates desirous of seeking admission have to attend the counseling in person along with the following original certificates and two sets of Xerox copies.

1. Rank Card : 2012
2. Entrance Test Hall Ticket : 2012
3. Original certificate (or provisional certificate if the original is not yet issued as per rules) of the qualifying examination
4. Consolidated Memorandum of Marks of the qualifying examination.
5. Secondary School Certificate (S.S.C.)
6. Proof of Local/Non-Local candidates, according to rules in force. Those who have studied Degree and P.G. courses as regular students need submit only the bonafide certificates from colleges where they have studied the said courses. In case the candidates have studied four consecutive years preceding the qualifying examination in more than one local area, the candidates must submit bonafide certificate(s) of Intermediate (In addition to the above). In case the candidate has not studied in any educational institution during part of 4/7 years preceding the qualifying examination, he/she has to submit a gap certificate from the MRO concerned.
7. Community, Nativity and Date of Birth Certificate for S.C., S.T., B.C., candidates as per G.O.Ms.No. 58, Social Welfare (J) Dept, dated 12-5-1997.

Notes:

1. The candidates, who fail to submit the certificates in original/proof of admission in this academic year in other institutions or fail to pay the fee on the spot, will not be considered for admission. **Fee once paid, will not be refunded.**
2. **If any candidate fails to attend the spot admission as per the given schedule when he/she is called for admission, he/she forfeits the claim for admission to the course.**
3. **More number of candidates are called for counseling to fill up all the seats. Therefore, mere attendance does not guarantee a seat.**
4. The genuineness or otherwise of the social status claim of the candidates seeking admission under SC/BC categories shall be verified by the Director of Social Welfare/Director of Backward Classes of Government of A.P., respectively, whose decision in this regards will be final. The admissions to the seats reserved for SC/BC shall be deemed provisional till the genuineness of the social status of the candidates is verified by the respective authorities cited above.
5. In the case of ST candidates, they should get their status verified by the Director of Tribal Welfare, Government of A.P., Telugu Sankshema Bhavan, Masab Tank, Hyderabad-20 before attending the spot admission, if necessary.
6. No TA and DA will be paid for attending the spot admissions and the candidates should come prepared to stay for a day or two beyond the actual date of spot admission, if necessary.
7. The University is not responsible either for any postal delay or loss during transit of this communication.
8. The admission of a candidate will be cancelled at any time during the course of study and the candidate is liable for criminal prosecution, if it is found that admission is secured on false grounds or by suppression of facts.
