Further the time prescribed for the above Part-I (C) is 3 Hrs with Indian Heritage & Culture 1 Hour 30 Minutes and Science & Civilization 1 Hour 30 Minutes.

Environmental studies paper is introduced in Final year of Three year Degree course under part III Paper III with code no. 9-2, which is made common under second year for the supplemental candidates who have appeared in September 2010 or earlier.
