

- The examinations of the candidates of Part-I of the School of Open Learning (Male & Female together) shall be held in two sessions i.e. Morning Session (9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon) and Afternoon Session (3:00 PM to 6:00 PM). The candidates are advised to report at their respective examination centres according to the time mentioned on their Admit Cards.
- The Examinations of the candidates of Part-II (including repeat papers of Part-I), Part-III (including repeat paper of Part-II & Part-I) of School of Open Learning as well as the examinations in respect of the candidates of Part-I, Part-II & Part-III of Non Formal Education Cell (External Candidates' Cell) shall be conducted in the Morning Session only (i.e. 9:00 AM to 12:00 Noon).


