- Date of Birth: Candidates of GE and OBC categories must have been born on or after 1st October 1987 and those of SC. ST and PD categories must have been born on or after 1st October 1982. Year of Passing Qualifying Examination (QE):
 - A candidate must have passed the QE namely, XII standard or equivalent, for the first time on or after 1st October 2010 or should be appearing in 2012. Minimum Percentage of Marks in QE: Candidates of GE
- and OBC categories must secure at least 60% marks, and those of SC, ST and PD categories must secure at least 55% marks in aggregate in the QE. Attempts Permitted: Those who appeared in JEE in 2010
 - or earlier are not eligible to appear in IIT-JEE 2012. Admission taken through JEE earlier: A candidate who has accepted admission, by paving registration fee, to any of the programmes at IITs, IT-BHU Varanasi and ISM Dhanbad based on performance in JEE-2011 will not be eligible to write IIT-JEE 2012, irrespective of whether or not

RESERVATION OF SEATS
