Applications are invited for admissions to M.Phil. courses being run by the various Departments of University and the affiliated College (Govt. College, Kota) for the session 2011-12. Admission to M.Phil. programme will be made through Entrance Examination and Interview as per rules and regulations of the University based on the UGC Notification (11-07-2009).

The subject-wise syllabus for the Entrance Examination will be the same as prescribed by the University of Kota for P.G. course of concerned subject for the session 2011-12.

**Eligibility:** Post Graduate Degree in the relevant subject with minimum 55 % marks (relaxation of 5 % for SC/ST/PH candidates).

### **Exemption from Entrance Test:**

1. Those who have qualified UGC/CSIR NET (JRF) examination (SET from Rajasthan only)/GATE (with a valid score) / Teacher Research Fellowship holder.
2. The students who qualify U.G.C. recognized J.R.F. test conducted by National /Govt. agencies such as ICSSR, ICPR etc.
3. A permanent University/College Teacher who is **appointed by RPSC**. In case of Teacher from an affiliated college the appointment must be approved by the University having a minimum five years teaching experience on regular basis.

The candidate, belongs to Category 1 to 3 for exemption, will have to submit the same application form with the required fee.
